

Union of Saints Statement on Women's Freedom

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At the Union of Saints, we advocate for one principle with absolute conviction:

American Freedom. End of story.

There is no such thing as American freedom without the full liberation, protection, and bodily sovereignty of women. Across this nation, women continue to face systems of coercion, domination, and exploitation. Old patterns of bondage have been repackaged in modern forms. These systems of control are not tradition. They are not culture. They are not moral positions. They are forms of slavery, and we name them as such.

Women suffer under sexual exploitation, reproductive control, economic confinement, political suppression, and the ongoing expectation that their bodies exist for the use, comfort, lineage, or approval of others. Whether the bondage appears as sex slavery, labor servitude, forced obedience, coerced pregnancy, financial domination, legal silencing, or any of the countless mechanisms used to break a woman's will, the truth remains the same:

Any system that claims authority over a woman's body or choices is a system of slavery.

Our position is unwavering. A woman's body is her own. Her womb belongs to no institution, no partner, no political party, no ideology, no lineage, and no community.

Her autonomy is not up for debate. Her boundaries are not subject to approval. Her freedom is not negotiable.

We reject every instrument of control, whether religious, political, familial, or cultural, that seeks to reduce women to property, caretakers, laborers, vessels, or ornaments. We reject any doctrine that demands women remain silent, compliant, grateful, or obedient at the cost of their health, dignity, or safety. We reject the false authority of anyone who believes they have the right to define a woman's worth, morality, purity, or destiny.

At the Union of Saints, we stand with women, and we stand against every form of bondage placed upon them, whether sexual, reproductive, economic, emotional, institutional, or spiritual. Freedom is not partial, conditional, or handed out by those in power. Freedom is inherent, God given, and non negotiable.

And so we say it without apology, where a woman is not free, America is not free. Where a woman's body is controlled, this nation has abandoned its highest ideals. Where a woman is forced, coerced, silenced, or shamed, justice has failed.

Our advocacy is simple:

American Freedom. Full stop.

And that begins with the liberation of women from every system that seeks to claim them.
