

Societal Mediation Proposal

The United States is experiencing extreme political division over issues such as immigration, border security, public safety, and the direction of the nation. These disagreements have contributed to growing distrust, heightened rhetoric, and increased hostility between Americans.

Many Republicans have expressed concerns that current immigration policies have resulted in harmful levels of migration that should be reduced. They advocate for stronger border security, enforcement of existing immigration laws, and legislative reforms that prioritize the interests of American citizens.

Many Democrats support different approaches to immigration and humanitarian policy, creating ongoing political conflict over how these issues should be addressed. Critics of these policies argue that some of their consequences may contribute to serious humanitarian concerns including crimes against humanity.

Political activist organizations and advocacy groups of every ideology should recognize their responsibility to avoid simplifying the issues, extremism and escalating division. Activism should never encourage hostility, intimidation, discrimination, harassment, or political violence. Where such conduct occurs, citizens have the right to seek justice through lawful means. Public policy debates should be conducted through lawful, peaceful, and democratic processes that respect constitutional rights and the equal dignity of every person.

Likewise, all political leaders, organizations, and supporters should reject threats, harassment, and violence directed at political opponents or public figures. Personal attacks and intimidation only worsen national division and make constructive dialogue more difficult.

Proposed Mediation

1. Work toward immigration policies that address border security, respect the nation's will, the American people, traditions, values, culture, and the rule of law. Close the chapter on open border policies and modern colonialism, including New American offices. End forced mass migration. Ensure that any future immigration reforms are debated openly and enacted through a transparent legislative process.
2. Encourage activist organizations, advocacy groups, political parties, and their supporters to reduce inflammatory rhetoric, reject fear, intimidation and political violence, avoid using labels like "White supremacy" to characterize or target American families, and engage in peaceful community participation.
3. Encourage all Americans, regardless of political affiliation, to resolve disagreements through democratic institutions, respectful dialogue, and lawful engagement rather than hostility or retaliation.

4. End unlawful foreign interference in American politics. Reject cold war tactics and unlawful foreign influence within American political institutions. Elect native officials and encourage them to represent and protect the interests of the communities they serve.
5. Reject extremist political ideologies that promote political violence, collective blame, or the targeting of innocent Americans. Encourage accountability based on individual conduct rather than guilt by association.
6. End the use of public funding for political advocacy through nonprofit organizations. Prohibit the use of American taxpayer funds to support foreign political activists or foreign political advocacy through domestic nonprofit organizations. Enact legislation establishing clear transparency, oversight, and accountability requirements to ensure that public funds are used only for their authorized public purposes and to help prevent similar concerns from arising in the future.
7. Where any organization, including a religious organization, has been found by a court to have violated applicable laws governing the use of public funds or government grants, review its eligibility to receive future taxpayer funding and impose appropriate restrictions or disqualification as provided by law.
8. Enact and enforce laws that prohibit taxpayer funds from supporting any organization, including religious organizations, that is found by a court to have engaged in criminal conduct, abuse, or unlawful practices. This includes crimes involving the abuse or exploitation of children, unlawful cruelty to animals, the construction of illegal structures or tunnels in violation of applicable laws, or any other conduct that violates criminal or public safety laws. Public funding should be contingent upon compliance with the law, transparency, and accountability.
9. Promote policies that preserve the peaceful enjoyment of public spaces for all residents. Apply regulations and bans governing the use of foreign or American culturally disruptive religious amplified sound, public demonstrations, and the construction and operation of buildings through existing zoning, noise, and public safety laws.
10. Prioritize American citizens in hiring and housing, consistent with applicable law, while ensuring that employment and housing practices remain transparent, merit based, and fair.

The purpose of this mediation is to reduce political conflict, encourage mutual respect, and promote peaceful solutions while allowing policy differences to be debated openly and resolved through the democratic process.
