

Union of Saints Verdict, National Security

We find members of the Democratic Party to be responsible for grave national security harms with real human cost, including the promotion of anti-statism; eugenics, including Black and Hispanic liberation eugenics and White antinatalism; activism characterized as terrorism or anarchy; arson; racism against White Americans; political conspiracy, blackmail, fraud, political human trafficking, including harem building, and sabotage of Americans; mass migration resulting in significant demographic shifts, as well as harms to American communities and spiritual life; political assassinations and attacks on members of the Republican Party; the formation of armed militias; looting; and other crimes. We further assert that this includes the support of foreign political interests, including Chinese communism and Russian kompromat or cyberwar campaigns.

These concerns extend to attacks on the military; ANTIFA; foreign influence campaigns; the use of public spending to support harmful protests; deficiencies in cybersecurity and infrastructure protection; the silencing of voices opposed to vaccination mandates; and the continued support of individuals who commit crimes against Americans, including femicidal harms against women.

While the Republican Party is not without imperfections, at this juncture in history it has coalesced in a concerted effort to safeguard the American people from the destabilizing threats associated with mass migration. In our view, this threat mirrors that of warbands in history, in that it includes efforts to enslave, rape, massacre a people, and change demographics and territory alignment from within.

Therefore, our position stands with our military, veterans, police, and other public servants as we stand face to face with the enemy. The choice to support the United States remains open to members of the Democratic Party; however, at present, we place greater confidence in the leadership and policy direction of the Republican Party.
