Arbor Lakes Canoe and Kayak Rules

All vessels owners must read the rules, fill out registration and sign the agreement at which time the Recreation Director or designee prior to receiving a slot.

Storage area is intended for Owners who use the lake on a regular basis.

A limited number of racks are provided near the shoreline and safe access to all storage racks is important.

Rack C is for kayaks not to exceed 10 feet in length and 36 inches wide.

Racks A,B,D are for remaining canoes and kayaks. Length and locations will be considered when assigning a vessel to a slot.

1. Arbor Lakes assumes no responsibility for vessels due to weather, theft or any other reason.
2. Arbor Lakes assumes no responsibility for damage caused by canoes or kayaks to other property.
3. Owners are encouraged to keep their vessels clean and water worthy.
4. Owners must keep their vessel securely attached and provide a lock for their vessel.
5. There is NO storage provided for paddles.
6. Residents may have the use of one slot per household, if available.
7. Seasonal users MUST remove their vessel from rack during their absence.

8. All vessels must be removed when Tropical Storm Warning is in effect. Vessels may be returned to racks **ONE** day after **ALL** warnings have been lifted.

9. During the Tropical Storm season if you are going to be out of town a week or longer please remove your canoe or kayak just in case weather changes during that time.

10. No cleaning of fish or disposing of fish at shoreline.

11. Feeding wildlife is **Prohibited** along the shoreline and in the waters.
