PASTOR'S REPORT

Grace and Peace to you, Brothers and Sisters in Christ!
Greetings in the name of the Risen One, our Lord Jesus Christ! As I write this report, I remember last year. For our Annual Meeting, life was very different. We had dates for a drive-thru to pick up the annual report booklet and we held our meeting via Facebook Live.

I write this as I am on sabbatical. I sincerely hope that we are able to have our Annual Meeting in person this year. This past year has been one of figuring out this terrain as we navigate new territory. We have taken steps forward knowing we may have to take steps back. For an organization that thrives on tradition and relationships, it is a challenging balance to strike between protecting and loving each other while also not letting COVID19 slow us down.

This has been a challenging year! What started as an acute crisis became a chronic one. We adapted again and again. I think many of us became weary. Maybe some of us felt isolated or complacent or discouraged. I am sure all the feelings and experiences we had were many; and I honor each one of them. I honor the challenge each of you faced as you did your best to adapt to the changing landscape.

The ability to adapt makes the difference when the landscape changes. According to the NC Synod, several churches closed. They could either not work together, maintain solvency, or put each other first. They closed because they could not adapt. I am grateful for this congregation's resilience, generosity, and

faithfulness. While other churches in the community may have been meeting in person before us, I do not know what criteria on which they based their decisions.

For us, we focused on the guidance put forth by the NC Synod and the CDC. We watched county infection rates as we considered our most vulnerable folks. These were decisions based on data, caution, and love. In May of 2021, we returned to indoor services. I am proud and grateful to say that thus far, no one has contracted COVID19 from attending church here at Sardis. I pray that continues!

I am grateful to God for each of you. I value your lives and your well-being. I understand that the guidelines and restrictions were frustrating at times. We are not used to hearing, "We may do this," and "we can't do that"! These recommendations assault our American sensibilities. In situations like these it can be hard to remember that our true citizenship is in heaven. Our first identity is 'baptized child of God'. As disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called to walk a different path: one where we put others first especially in times of hardship, inconvenience, and even in the face of death. As Martin Luther said, "A Christian is both subject to none and subject to all."

As we were in the process of reopening in April and May, we had some challenging discussions. I think what made the most difference were our prayers asking that our conversations be productive. As we continue to walk this path together, I ask wholeheartedly that we pray for continued guidance. While this experience is unprecedented and will be part of our history, I hope it is one we do not repeat.

Cont. Pastor's Report

As our worship practices for services and funerals were constantly changing because of Shifting factors, I came to rely heavily on the Worship & Music Committee for guidance. I would like to lift up Becky Gladden, Chair of Worship & Music, and the members of the Worship & Music Committee for their courageous leadership during this time. Their concern focused on keeping our members safe, especially our most vulnerable members. I am grateful to Becky and the committee members for their faithfulness to this concern even as some of the recommendations brought pushback. All of the decisions formally made were ultimately made by church council. Please take the time to thank Becky and the other members of the Committee for their deep love of the people of Sardis.

What matters most for us is our mission. Our focus and our purpose as Sardis Evangelical Lutheran Church is *that we serve together as disciples of Christ, teach the Word to invite people into a life of knowing Jesus, encourage each other in faith and personal mission through reaching out to the needs of the community and individuals.* This, as well as what Paul writes to the people of Philippi in Philippians 4:8: "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me--put it into practice."

I would like to share what I think is true, noble, right, pure and admirable. That is, of course, our Gracious Heavenly Father, our Redeeming Savior, and our Advocate, the Holy Spirit! It is also YOU and the ministry we share! I am grateful for you. I am inspired and formed by you. I give thanks for the way the Holy Spirit has worked in us and through us this past year.

- We proclaimed the Gospel of Jesus Christ outside our walls with drive-in worship services.
- We hosted speakers for our online Lenten Series on love of self and others. Speakers were distinguished professionals in their respective areas of caring for self, creation care, poverty, health care, and racial justice.
- We engaged in an online Lenten study called "Six Weeks on Money" where we explored what it looks like to live generously.
- We resumed in-person meetings and indoor worship services.
- The Council held extra meetings and met diligently to complete four sessions of the study "Thriving Beyond Covid19" to prepare for our Council Retreat.
- Council met for a retreat to discern vision and goals for us.
- Our Christian Education Committee organized an exciting Rally Day to kick off Sunday School. They also worked very hard to explore new Sunday School formats and approaches.
- Social Ministry collected canned food, jackets, coats, and many other items throughout the year.
- We have a new Blessing Box for books and food for community members.
- We re-started the Prayer Group and continue to meet bi-weekly online.

- We held a First Communion Class and celebrated the first communion of Cayden Hood, Graysen Whitener, Hayden Johnson, Keaton Farnsworth, Lexi Wood, and Paisley Hood on Reformation Sunday.

- We held our second Live Drive-thru Nativity on December 19th. So much food was collected and shared with ECCCM.

We lost many dear ones this past year. Joe Fulbright, Dwight Gladden, Emma Jean Jarrett, Betty Clay, Kathleen Weaver. Let us hold their families in prayer for peace and comfort. I give thanks for our new members William, Lindsey, Keaton, Rhiannon, and Lincoln Farnsworth, and our newly baptized Clay Smyre. I also thank you for the warm welcome you gave to the sweet little boy I fostered, Brysen. He loved attending church here and wanted to give you all a huge hug as he went to live with the loving family who adopted him. Thank you for your great hospitality and care.

I would also like to lift up what a wonderful Synod we have. At our virtual Synod Assembly in May, The Rev. Dr. Timothy Smith was re-elected to serve another six-year term as our Bishop. He is a caring and an effective leader. The Synod created a COVID19 Relief Fund and awarded us over \$3,500 for technology needs and \$3,000 in support of my sabbatical leave. The staff continues to serve the rostered ministers and congregations in the Synod.

I am grateful to our committees and committee chairs. Thank you for the good work that you do. Thank you to everyone who humbly and quietly makes things happen. Your ministry is appreciated! I am grateful for our Council VP, Bruce Sigman, who led us faithfully this year. I am grateful for Jane and the great job she does providing administrative support. Our PA system is very old and the technology team has worked diligently to keep it operational and provide an enjoyable worship experience. This has included isolating wiring issues, replacing cables, soldering connections, fixing and replacing equipment. A small portable PA tower was added to ensure members could hear at outdoor services.

We continued to use phone and text message delivery systems extensive to convey information to our members. Bulletins and other worship materials were delivered via Facebook and our website. All of these have allowed us to provide worship experiences to our members while keeping them safe.

In the office, our copier was replaced with a new one by our service contract resulting in a cheaper printing cost. Our internet connection was also upgraded with faster service at a lower price.

Sardis continues to thrive under the leadership of Pastor Adrienne Martin and Music Director Frank Griffin. Together they plan and compose worship experiences that are meaningful and promote healing and wholeness to all attending. We are so thankful that God led them both to us.

We began the year with our worship services on-line only as COVID-19 cases were setting record highs in our area.

Sunday evening Lenten services were also recorded and available online. This year's theme was "Love our Neighbor and Who is Our Neighbor?" The services featured very informative and inspiring speakers representing a variety of community resources. Thank you to Pastor Adrienne for making the contacts and organizing the guest speakers and services.

In March, with the return of warmer temperatures and the wider availability of vaccines, the council approved Worship & Music's recommendation to resume our outdoor drive-in services. We thank Joe Biggerstaff for use of his recording equipment and knowledge, Bruce Sigmon and Ben Whitener for the use of their trailers which were used as our "outdoor chancel", and to Terry Bledsoe and Ben Whitener for recording the services so that online worship continued as an option. Thank you to the many other volunteers who helped make our drive-in services successful.

By the end of May, vaccines availability was wide-spread and we were able to return to worship inside our sanctuary, although with a number of changes and precautions as recommended by our Synod and approved by our church council.

Frank Griffin, our music director, spent countless hours preparing alternative ways to include music and singing into our services in a safe manner. We are so grateful to Frank and to the families who came in mid-week to record hymns until it was safer to have congregational singing with masks.

September 12, we returned outdoors as our Homecoming service and meal were held on the front lawn. We were so pleased to have Pastor Mary Louise Sitton as our guest pastor. We were also able to continue our celebrations of ordained women in the ELCA. We presented Pastor Mary Louise with a hand carved box, made by Terry Bledsoe, filled with gifts from the congregation. Per council's request our meal was catered by Jason's Deli.
