WHAT IS LENT?

Lent is a solemn 40-day period preceding Easter, characterized by fasting, prayer, and repentance as believers prepare for the celebration of Easter Sunday . The word "Lent" comes from the Old English word "lencten," which means "springtime" or "spring" . During this time, Christians often engage in practices such as fasting, prayer, and almsgiving as a way to deepen their connection with God and to reflect on the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross . Fasting during Lent typically involves abstaining from certain foods or luxuries as a form of self-discipline and solidarity with the sufferings of Christ . The Lenten season serves as a period of spiritual purification, allowing believers to renew their faith and draw closer to the core tenets of Christianity .

WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF 40 DAYS?

The number 40 has a significant meaning in Christianity and is found 24 times throughout the Bible . It is often associated with periods of trial, testing, and preparation. For example, Jesus fasted for 40 days and 40 nights in the wilderness before beginning his public ministry . Similarly, the flood in the story of Noah lasted for 40 days and 40 nights . In the Old Testament, Moses spent 40 days and 40 nights on Mount Sinai receiving the Ten Commandments . The number 40 is also associated with Lent, which is a 40-day period of fasting, prayer, and repentance leading up to Easter Sunday . The significance of 40 days in Christianity is often linked to the idea of spiritual purification and renewal

HOW DO CHRISTIANS CELEBRATE EASTER?

Easter is one of the most important Christian holidays, celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead after his crucifixion and burial. The day is typically marked by special church services, music, candlelight, flowers, and the ringing of church bells. It is a day of joy and celebration to commemorate that Jesus Christ is risen, according to Christian belief².

The Easter season begins with Lent, a 40-day period of fasting, repentance, moderation, and spiritual discipline in preparation for Easter. In Western Christianity, Ash Wednesday marks the start of Lent, while Easter Sunday marks the end of Lent and the Easter season. Eastern Orthodox churches observe Lent or Great Lent, during the 6 weeks or 40 days preceding Palm Sunday with fasting continuing during the Holy Week of Easter.

The week preceding Easter is called Holy Week. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday, the celebration of Jesus Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. On Maundy Thursday, there is a commemoration of the Last Supper when Jesus shared the Passover meal with his disciples on the night before he was crucified. Jesus' death by crucifixion is commemorated on Good Friday.

Easter traditions vary across the Christian world and include flowering the cross, the wearing of Easter bonnets by women, clipping the church, and the decoration and the communal breaking of Easter eggs (a symbol of the empty tomb).
