holidays, you might have already decided your resolution, if that is your practice.

I am thinking a little differently about New Year resolutions this year. I had stopped making New Year's resolutions because I found that they seemed futile and would typically abandon them by the end of January. It would always be some self-improvement goal that seemed to be unfulfilling or just an opportunity for failure. However, I know that there are plenty of folks and resolutions that work and I applaud that. However, I wonder if there is a more life-giving approach to resolution-making.

Perhaps it relates to the nature of the goals we set. We often set them for ourselves; they are typically self-centered, at least mine have been in the past. What if, instead, we set goals or resolutions based on what others need from us? Do we ever make goals that make us better for the people around us? Do we ever think about what the people around us need from us and how that might require us to change? Would that in the end contribute to the more self-centered goals we might have set?

What if we asked those around us how we could be better for them this year? For example, a resolution may be to not have road rage. Is it so you feel more peace or to be less uptight for your family when you get home? If you would like to cultivate patience, is it so you can feel better about your capacity in dealing with difficult circumstance or so you can be present to the person who needs you? As an experiment, I asked my family what they needed from me for 2020. And now I have a new goal to work on!

This is not an easy task, if you choose to try it. It is human to think about ourselves. Even Jesus had the humanity of struggling with an outward goal. In the hours before his death on the cross in the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus prayed that the cup be taken from him if it were God's will...but he saw that more was needed. He knew what was needed for the salvation of others. He went to the cross on our behalf. We can transcend ourselves for what others need.

For this year if you focus on goals and resolutions, consider what the people around you need from you so that you can be better for them. It could be patience, time, grace, encouragement, attention, gratitude, or being more present. Pick one thing that would make you better for the people around you. And 12 months from now, you'll thank yourself!
