In order to compete in the Saddlebred divisions, horses must be registered with the American Saddlebred Registry and shown under the name of the owner(s) or lessor(s) of record. Opportunity classes are open to horses of ANY breed (Registered or Not). The Academy division will be judged according to Georgia Academy rules and guidelines. Saddle seat, Hunt seat, and Stock Seat horses may be entered and will be judge accordingly (Detailed Georgia Academy Rules are posted at [www.ashag.org](http://www.ashag.org)).

# ACADEMY Program Notes and Rules

**ACADEMY entries CLOSE AT 7:00 PM on FRIDAY. Non-Championship classes will be split if there are more than TWELVE total entries (or based on Management discretion). CHAMPIONSHIP classes may or may not be split (based on class size). Any class SPLITS will be posted IN THE SHOW OFFICE by FRIDAY EVENING.**

- Academy classes are open to mares and geldings of ANY equine breed, registered or non-registered, including drafts, ponies and miniature horses (Stallions of any breed are prohibited from showing in Academy classes).
- To show in the Academy division, horses and ponies DO NOT have to be used in professional riding program, but they MUST display the characteristics and manners of a horse capable of being safely used in a supervised lesson scenario.
- Show Horses MAY be used in LEAD LINE classes but must be able to stand quietly and be led calmly at a FLAT walk.
- In order for an Academy horse to be eligible to show at the Academy National Championships, that horse or pony MUST be currently utilized in a public or private riding lesson program (per Academy National Rules and Requirements).
- In Academy classes, ONLY the rider, driver or handler is to be judged. The quality or soundness of the Academy horse or pony is not to be a determining factor in judging of the class. The following Academy divisions may be offered, with age-splits as deemed appropriate by horse show management:

**Academy Equitation Classes** – RIDER is to be judged on their basic equitation posture and skills, including the correct use of reins, aids, diagonals, and leads, at a beginning rider level.

**Academy Showmanship Classes** – RIDER is to be judged on horsemanship and showmanship skills, such as control of the horse and ability to transition the horse correctly into its proper gaits. Ability to walk the horse and execute correct canter leads will be judged, as well as ability to manage speed, collection and ring placement.

**Academy Driving Classes** – DRIVER is to be judged on his/her ability to manage the horse or pony in the ring and show at the walk, trot and reverse (backing is not required). Division is open to any amateur driver who has never shown in a recognized competitive driving event. An Academy Driver may cross-enter under saddle Academy classes at the same show if other eligibility requirements are met.

**Academy In-Hand Classes** – The HANDLER is to be judged on horsemanship, showmanship, and appropriate handling and turn-out of both horse and handler, based on breed-specific in-hand guidelines.

**Academy “Show Rider” Classes** – Advanced classes may be offered for ANY age Amateur/Juvenile rider that is enrolled in a professionally-operated riding lesson program. Show Riders must show with lesson-program horses, but MAY cross-enter as eligible into regular performance divisions at the same show.

- **SAFETY** in the Academy division is paramount - At the discretion of the Judge or Ringmaster, any rider deemed to be too inexperienced, or mounted on a horse that is considered to be un-safe, will be excused from the show ring.
- **IMPORTANT** - All Academy riders and drivers aged 17 and Under MUST wear a helmet on the grounds and in the ring.
- Absolutely NO whips, plastic bags, noise or other attention-getting devices are allowed in warm-up or show ring areas or when riders are in the ring for Academy classes.
- Academy exhibitors may show in regular In-Hand or Halter classes at the same show, without being ruled ineligible for Academy riding and driving classes.
- Riders who have been judged in any Non-Academy class at ANY prior show may not return to the Academy Division during that same season. Riders who have cantered in any prior show class are NO LONGER ELIGIBLE to enter Walk & Trot Only Academy classes.

# Horse Show Rules and Regulations

This show is sponsored by the **Southeastern Charity** and **American Saddlebred Horse Association of Georgia (ASHAG)**, and is conducted as a non-USEF rated ASHBA "STAR" competition. ASHBA and USEF rules will be followed unless otherwise specified. The Southeastern Charity, ASHAG and the Georgia International Horse Park (GHIP) will NOT be responsible for any accident or loss that may occur to any person, animal, or property while attending this event.

Any owner, exhibitor, trainer or stable that has outstanding fees, including but not limited to non-sufficient funds (returned) checks, stop payment checks, disputed credit card charges, etc. will NOT be permitted to show and/or exhibit until ALL fee payments have been fully satisfied with Show Management. Management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee or stabling fees before or during the show (at its sole discretion).

**ENTRIES:** Closing date for entries is **SEPTEMBER 10<sup>th</sup>** - Each online entry or paper entry form must be completed, with all horse, rider and class information fully and clearly completed. Payment or Open Check must accompany each entry or be presented upon Check-in. Horses or Riders must be entered and must pre-qualify for ALL championship classes. Entries not paid in full, or received after closing date, except for championship classes, may incur a **Post Entry Fee**.

**PAYMENT:** No entries will be accepted and no stalls reserved or barn positions held unless accompanied by Open Check or other payment for both stalls and entry fees. Checks must be made payable to **Southeastern Charity Horse Show**. PayPal "friends and Family" payments may be sent to [lori.schmidt@outlook.com](mailto:lori.schmidt@outlook.com) and Credit Cards are accepted with a 5% Card Processing Fee. All fees must be paid BEFORE back numbers will be issued. Non-Stalled horses will be charged a daily Grounds Fee as per Entry Form. **ALL Accounts must be settled by 7:00 PM on or before the LAST day of the SHOW.**

**RETURNED CHECKS:** All checks should be made payable to **Southeastern Charity Horse Show**. Any check returned for non-sufficient funds will incur a **Handling Fee of \$50.00**. Any trainer or owner who has a bad check or handling fee outstanding will NOT be allowed to show until outstanding debts are settled in full with the Show Office.

**REFUNDS:** In case(s) of horses being entered and not exhibited, Office Fees and Stall Fees are NOT refundable after closing date, but Entry fees and Exhibitor Fees will be refunded. Please notify the Horse Show Office of any scratches as soon as possible.

**NEGATIVE COGGINS:** A valid negative Coggins Test within **12 Months** of the show end date must be submitted with horse entries or presented at the show office before numbers are released.

**POST ENTRY and CHANGES:** Post entries will be accepted for an added horse, equitation, or academy rider (Post Entry Fee may be charged based on management discretion). Scratches and changes for previously entered exhibitors must be made at least 2 hours prior to show session start time.

**STALLS:** Stalls will be available from **Tuesday at 8:00 am** through **Sunday at Noon**, unless early arrival arrangements have been made. No stalls will be reserved unless guaranteed with a check or credit card (5% card processing fee to be added to credit card payments). Stalls are assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis with priority consideration given to previous attendance and show sponsorship. Barn assignments are at the full discretion of show management. Requests for specific barns or stalls will be considered but are not guaranteed. **NO initial bedding** will be supplied.

**BEDDING:** Bedding will be available and **MUST** be ordered directly from the Official Bedding Supplier of the Georgia International Horse Park. (**See Prize List and Entry Blank for Queenwood Contact Information**). Bedding will be pre-delivered if ordered in advance. NO outside bedding company deliveries are allowed.

**EARLY ARRIVAL:** Horses will not be allowed on the grounds before 8:00 am on Tuesday, unless arrangements have been made in advance. An Early Arrival Fee will be charged for any stalls required before Tuesday morning. Contact the Show Manager or Grounds Manager as soon as possible if early arrival is planned or necessitated.

**GROUND and STABLES:** Gas, electric or propane heaters, tanks and hot plates are prohibited in the stable area. All electrical extension cords used must be 12 gauge, 3 wire and prong negative type. **NO SMOKING** is allowed IN ANY BUILDING, RESTROOM or STABLE on the Show Grounds!

**DAMAGES:** Owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the showgrounds and will be charged accordingly. All barns and stalls must be left configured the same way they were found (walls replaced, stall doors re-hung, etc.) Any mulch, plants, rocks, decorations, etc. must be removed. Any fines assessed by the Horse Park to the Show (which may be **up to \$500**) for stable reconfiguration or clean-up will be billed to the stall renter of record.

**HORSES:** All horses must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the judge may, if he so desires, have the horse examined by the show veterinarian, and his or her decision will be final. No Exhibitor may use a veterinarian statement to contradict the judge's decision.

**SHOW RING:** No person or animal will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitors and those having official duties to perform. No horse, rider or driver will be allowed in the show ring except at such hours as posted in the show office.

**GATE HOLDS:** Gate hold requests must be made to the PADDOCK MASTER in advance of the session, and will be **limited to three (3) minutes**. Emergency holds may be accepted by the Paddock Master at his or her discretion.

**RING PROCEDURES:** The gate to the show ring will remain open for **two (2) minutes** after the first horse enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. All riders, drivers, attendants, and grooms shall be neatly and appropriately dressed upon entering warm up areas and show ring.

**DISCOURTESY:** ANY act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge, officials, or other exhibitors, on the part of the owner, trainer, manager, rider, driver, or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse or rider, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and all other fees, as well as any prize money won. In the case of such disqualification, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall receive the prize that had been awarded the disqualified exhibitor.

**CAMPERS:** Camper and RV hookups are available and reservations may be made with entries or by sending an email note to [lori.schmidt@outlook.com](mailto:lori.schmidt@outlook.com) in advance with RV details and hook-up requirements. PLEASE check in at Horse Show Office or with the GROUNDS MANAGER upon arrival. If you are arriving after office hours electrical boxes may not be open - you will need assistance!

**PARKING and Golf Carts:** All trucks, vans, horse trailers, and RVs, after unloading, must park in one of the designated parking lots or RV camping areas. **RVs and Campers must have an SCHS Parking Permit** visible in a window by the entrance (obtain at Show Office). Golf carts are available for rental or may be brought in by exhibitors, but they are to be operated **ONLY** on the show grounds and must be driven by a fully-licensed driver.

**PETS:** Pets are allowed on the show grounds and in the stables but must remain contained or on a leash at all times, which is the pet owner's full and sole responsibility.

**DISPUTES:** Should any question arise that is not provided for in these rules, it shall be referred to the SHOW MANAGER for answer or resolution. The decision of the Show Manager shall be final.

**LIABILITY:** Neither the Southeastern Charity Horse Show, the American Saddlebred Horse Association of Georgia, the Show Chairmen, Show Manager, the Georgia International Horse Park, nor any official, contractor, volunteer or sponsor will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any owner, rider, driver, groom, attendant, animal, or equipment at the show. Each show participant exhibits or attends at their own risk.
