

## A Hug and a Rug for your Mug.



### What you need:

- 4.5mm needles.
- 1 ball of Woolganic Organic Merino 8ply DK or equivalent heavy DK or light worsted yarn.
- Yarn needle for weaving in the ends and attaching button.
- Button for your Mug Hug.
- Crochet needle for weaving in the fringe.

This pattern is licence free. Feel free to knit this for small scale commercial purposes, making sure to credit Cathy Rubin, the designer.

**Mug Hug:**

Cosy for standard sized 10inch/25cms diameter mug.



Cast on 45sts

Cast off using this method:

Attach your chosen button to the opposite end to your buttonhole and block gently.

**Mug Rug:**

(coaster)



Cast on 25sts

**Row 1:** K5, p5, k5, p5, k5,**Row 2:** P5, k5, p5, k5, p5**Row 3:** K5, p5, k5, p5, k5**Row 4:** P5, k5, p5, k5, p5**Row 5:** K5, p5, k5, p5, k5**Row 6:** P5, k5, p5, k5, p5**Row 7:** P5, k5, p5, k5, p5**Row 8:** K5, p5, k5, p5, k5**Row 9:** P5, k5, p5, k5, p5**Row 10:** K5, p5, k5, p5, k5**Row 11:** P5, k5, p5, k5, p5**Row 12:** K5, p5, k5, p5, k5

Repeat the last 12 rows 2 times more.

For the fringe cut two strands 10cms in length. Attach two fringes to each knitted square using this link:

And then block gently.
