Our Café History

2021

Members of Daytona Beach Christian Church meet and begin the process of applying to be in the Recovery Cafe Network, which provides training and support for opening a Recovery Cafe.

The Founding Board and team are recruited and begin training.

2022

ReNew Recovery Café is officially incorporated as a 501c(3). We sign a lease, renovate, and officially open our doors in December!



2023

Thanks to a \$15,000 grant from Clay Electric Foundation and individual donors, we renovated our kitchen to provide healthy meals every day we are open.

Our Coffee Station opened in January, ready to provide specialty coffee drinks to all who come to the Café.





We continue to host our Annual Building Bridges Fundraising Breakfast in March, raising awareness about the Café and necessary funding to continue providing vital recovery support to our community.







Continuing to Build: In June, our staff continued training in the Choices Recovery Coach program. We also received a new two-year grant in partnership with the Volusia County Opioid Abatement Fund to grow our community outreach for our neighbors experiencing homelessness.

The ReNew Recovery Café model is Membership-based, offering a structure for individuals to develop healthy relationships and receive accountability and support that empowers them to gain and maintain recovery and fulfill their potential.

We support Members through:

- Recovery Circles (weekly support groups)
- Empowerment groups
- Art, yoga, computer, & nutrition classes
- Meals and coffee 4 days a week



ReNew Recovery Café is committed to stewarding our resources wisely. As we move forward into 2024 and 2025, an important goal is to diversify our financial resources to ensure sustainability. We seek to raise dollars for an Emergency Fund in the amount of \$75,000, which would cover over two months of operation during natural ebbs and flows of government funding.

For every dollar spent on recovery support, **ELEVEN** dollars are saved in the public funding for police, emergency room care and jail. (2014, National Institute of Health)

Together, we can create a more compassionate and supportive Recovery Ready community which benefits the most vulnerable members of Daytona Beach.
