

Guest Information



Bothy door key - Please remove the key before opening or closing the door as it marks the frame, thank you.

Parking - Please use the allocated parking area. You may use the gravel area for turning to drive in or drive out.

Heating - The radiators are oil and gel filled. You may put items of clothing on them. They are on a thermostat, if it is too hot or too cold please let us know and we will adjust them. The bathroom has a heated towel rail. The switch for this is in the kitchen.

Hot Water - The thermostat has been pre set. If at any time you are unhappy with the level of hot water please contact your hosts. Please note, a button on the shower control when pushed allows for hotter water.

Laundry - Your hosts offer a washing and drying service for an extra cost of £10 per load.

Please do not hang wet clothing over the shower screen/shower tray. If there is not enough room on the hangers over the radiator in the kitchen please ask your hosts to hang overnight/dry for you.

Toaster/Kettle - Please ensure the toaster and kettle, when in use, are forward of the overhead cupboards to prevent steam/heat damage.

Appliances - Guides on how to use the appliances are in this folder but if you are in any doubt your hosts will be only too happy to help.

Septic Tank

Please only put toilet paper in the toilet

A bin and bags are provided for sanitary products etc. The tank is also sensitive to cleaning chemicals, **NO BLEACH** please only use the eco products provided.

DO NOT put any fats or food waste down the sink or toilet.

Health and Safety

Fire - A fire blanket and fire extinguisher are located on the wall in the kitchen.

The tall narrow window in the bedroom is an emergency exit and can be opened as a door in the event of a fire in the kitchen area. In the event of a fire in the bedroom, please use the front door. Make your way to the main house, if fire does not allow make your way outside the gate turn right and walk to the driveway of the next house 'Corrie'.

First Aid - A basic first aid kit is located in the top of the wardrobe.

Power Failure - The push lights under the kitchen units are battery operated and a lantern is provided on the book case.

Due to our location and living in a high fire risk area - no smoking, candles, outdoor fires or BBQs are permitted on the premises.

This is an **ECO build** and therefore has no log burner. Electricity is created from an Air Sourced Heat Pump. The building is highly insulated.

Materials used in the build are mostly carbon neutral and/or recyclable.

Clothes washing/drying service

Wee Bee is a beautiful architect-designed eco bothy situated on the edge of the Tormore Forest in Capisdale, Armadale on the Sleat Penninsular. The Bothy offers fantastic coastal views across the sound of Sleat to mainland Scotland, down to the Ardnamurchan peninsular. With a spectacular view of Eigg as you come around to us on the costal road. This part of the island known as 'the garden of Skye' and has some of the best scenery that the island has to offer, but also award-winning restaurants and other attractions which will cater for every taste.

Completed in March 2023, this little hideaway has it all; eco-friendly air source heating system, ultra-insulation, Smart TV, luxury furnishings, making it warm and comfortable, no matter what time you choose to visit. Tastefully and stylishly furnished throughout, the property offers accommodation for two guests. The bothy has been positioned to take full advantage of the views, with the large windows in the open-plan living/sleeping area enjoying extensive sea and forest views.

A king size bed, quality bed linen and towels are provided. The bathroom has a spacious shower. The kitchenette, though small, offers everything you need for your stay. Outside, the patio area has a table and seating (to be completed by the end of 2023), and off-road parking.

This is the perfect place to immerse yourself in nature, with many outdoor activities available, including kayaking, shooting and fishing. There are lots of hiking trails to explore some of the islands most beautiful spots, with both coastal and woodland routes available. From the southern tip of the peninsula, the Point of Sleat, there is an amazing sandy beach with gorgeous views across the sea to the Small Isles.

There are plenty of attractions for those who prefer to spend time indoors. This is the former territory of the MacDonalds of Sleat, who had their base at Armadale Castle. Here, you can learn about their history at the Clan Donald Centre and meander around its beautiful gardens. Whisky connoisseurs can tour the Torabhaig Distillery and sample some of their "water of life". Spend the evening with good food and drink at the The Inn at Àird a' Bhàsair, only 2.5 miles away from Wee Bee Bothy.

Despite being a peninsula, Sleat is an excellent base for exploring Skye and the Western Highlands. There is easy access to the rest of Skye and its world famous attractions, including the Cuillin Mountains, the Quiraing and the island's largest town, Portree. The beauty of Wee Bee is being able to escape the busy areas and enjoy lots of peace and tranquillity.

Wee Bee is only a few miles (20 minutes) south from the ferry terminal, where you can take a short 30-minute ferry to Mallaig, Visit the golden beaches at Morar. From here, there are onward connections via road, ferry and rail to Fort William via the West Highland Line (made famous by the Harry Potter films) over the Glenfinnan viaduct. Ferrys from Mallaig also take you to the small isles Eigg, Rum, Canna and Muck as well as over to South Lewis.

Via the Skye bridge you can drive into Torridon it takes only 2 hours for spectacular mountain scenery and the famous Loch Marie. The Applecross peninsular is slightly closer and well worth a visit as is the famous Eilean Donan Castle.

The Balmacara estate has some great walks. Plockton has a beautiful harbour with great places to eat, gift shops and boat trips.

The drive to the North of the Island takes 1.5 hours, there is so much to see of Skye a week just isn't enough.
