This indenture made and entered into this 2<sup>d</sup> day of February 1834 by and between Henry T. Cromwell and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and George H. Cromwell & William Thompson Trustees for the protestant Episcopal Church in Boone County of the other part Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged having given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell to said parties of the second part for the use of said Church to Erect a house of public worship and for any other purposes to which said Church may wish to dedicate the same the following described piece of land lying adjoining the town of Cynthia on the east side of the back street of said town and bounded as follows: Commencing at one hundred feet North of the North west corner of Margaret Peans lot thence East back to the said road thence North with the said road one hundred feet thence West back to back street thence South one hundred feet to the beginning. To have and to hold said piece of land and every part thereof to said trustees for the uses aforesaid to their successors forever and the parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that they will forever warrant and defend the title to said land hereby conveyed against all claims whatsoever. In testimony of which said Cromwell and wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the date first above written.
