 Winter seasonal closures at Alpine Boat Launch and Ferry Peak Park.

SKI AT YOUR OWN RISK

Don't ski on closed trails, attend to cautionary trail signs.
 Do not obstruct ski trails or intersections
 When stopped, step to the side, out of tracks.
 Yield to skiers that overtake you.
 Practice good trail etiquette. Smile, Wave, Say Hello
 Know trail difficulty symbols, ski within your abilities.
 Where pets are allowed, please keep them under control and pick up after them.

Pedestrians, Snowmobilers, Fat Bikers and Snowshoers.

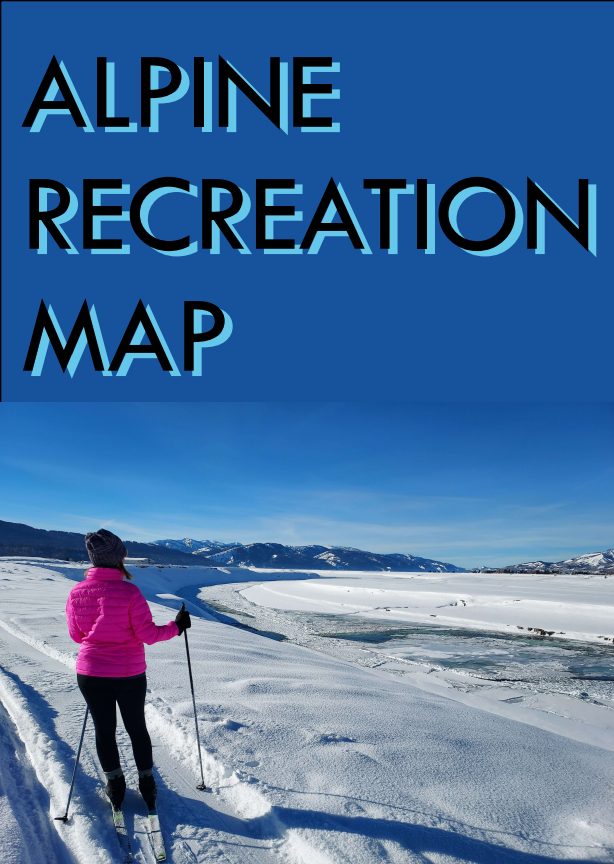
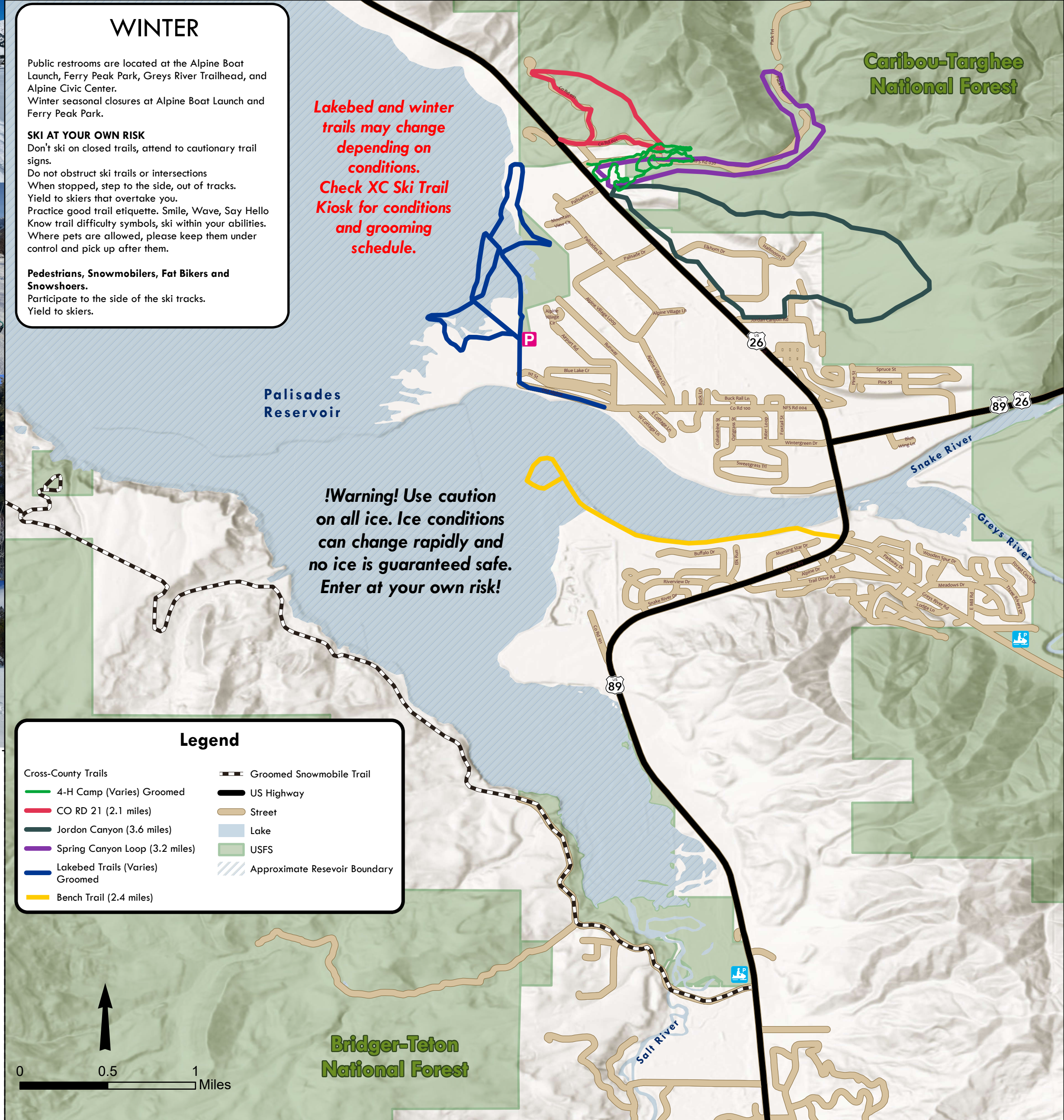
Participate to the side of the ski tracks.

Cross Country Trail Details

4-H Camp - A fun 2 mile classic track through the 4-H trees and camp. Currently this is for classic xc skiing only. Off hwy 26 turn into the 4-h camp to access the trailhead. 4-H is open in the winter to XC Skiing. See Alpinetap.org for any updates.

The Lakebed trails are flat, and are known for being dog friendly.

Snowmobile Trail Details

McCoy Creek Road, groomed from Alpine, WY to Herman, ID, 58 miles.

Greys River Road, groomed road to Box Y Lodge, 28 miles.

Follow posted speed limits.
 Respect Seasonal Closures.
 Check USFS Motor Vehicle Use Map to determine where snowmobiles are allowed.
 Use Permits are required of all Snowmobiles. Check the local jurisdiction for regulations and permit fee information.

Front and rear lights are recommended at all times while riding Fat Bikes on multi-use trails. Fat bikes are permitted on cross-country ski trails, please respect and avoid the tracks.
