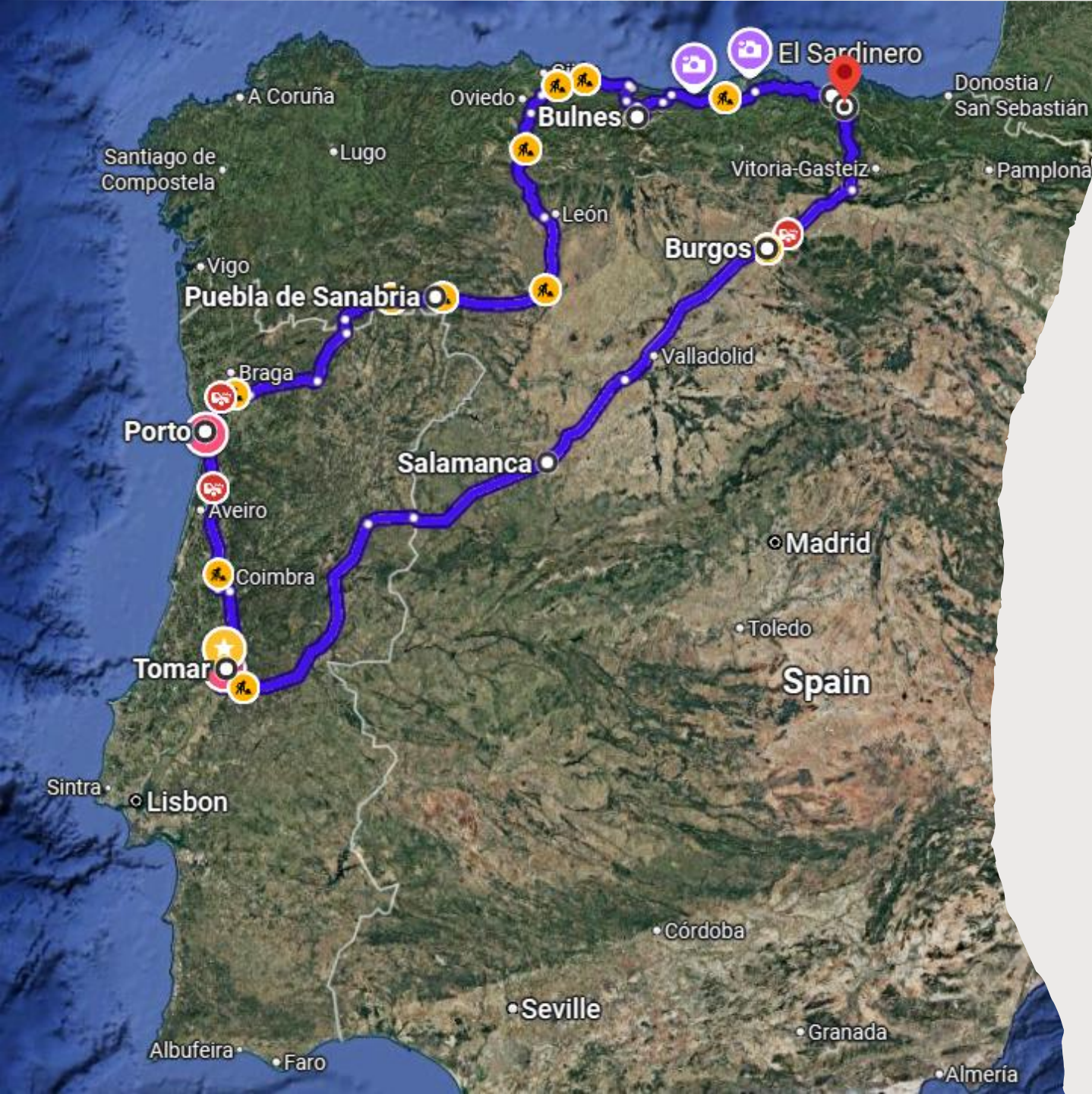

Day 3

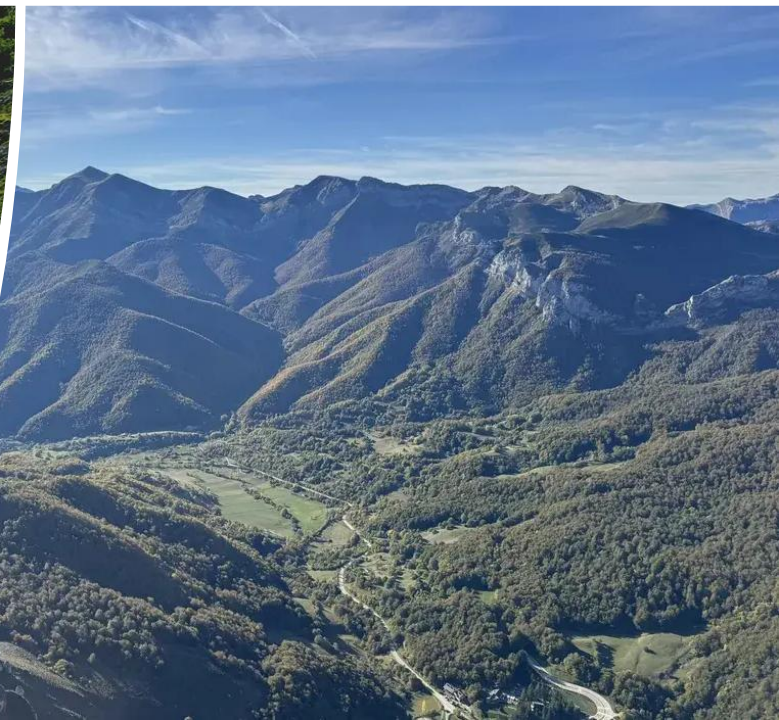
Bulnes, De Picos, Spain

Bulnes is a remote, car-free village in the heart of the Picos de Europa mountains in Asturias, Spain. Famous for its proximity to the iconic Naranjo de Bulnes (Picu Urriellu), it offers traditional stone houses, cafes, and stunning mountain views.

Naranjo de Bulnes (Picu Urriellu): The iconic, nearly 2,519-meter peak is visible from the village, with a popular viewpoint for viewing it.

Located just metres from Duje River, the Hotel Arcea Mirador has its very own cider bar and restaurant serving traditional Asturias cuisine.

The hotel is a central point for cultural attractions such as Cabrales Cheese Cave and boasts some of the scenery of the Picos de Europa.

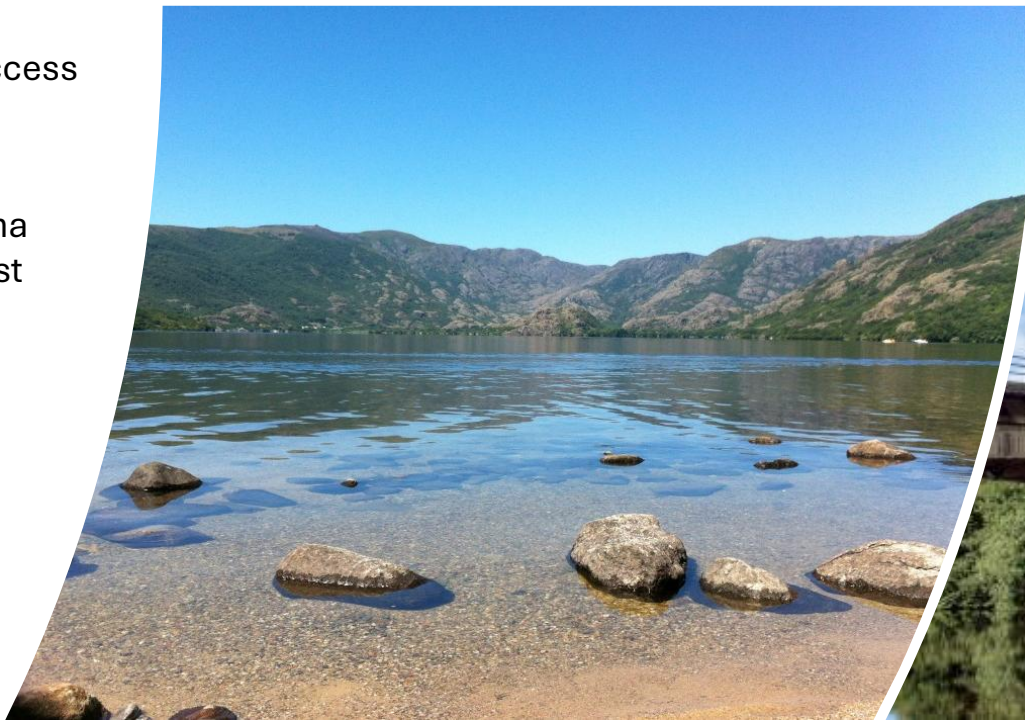


Day 4

Puebla de Sanabria, Spain

Puebla de Sanabria is a charming, historic town in Zamora, northwest Spain, recognized for its medieval architecture, 15th-century castle, and strategic location near the Portuguese border. Set at the confluence of the Tera and Castro rivers, this "Historic-Artistic Site" offers scenic, cobblestone streets, traditional Sanabresa cuisine, and easy access to the nearby Sanabria Lake Natural Park.

Both Hotels, La Hoja de Roble and La Trucha are located in the heart of the walled city just metres from the Rio Tera River. Both Hotels are well positioned for a vast array of restaurants offering world renowned Benavente gastronomy.



Day 5

Porto, Portugal

Porto, a vibrant coastal city in northwest Portugal, is renowned for its stately bridges, port wine production, and UNESCO-listed Ribeira district. As the country's second-largest city, it offers a dense, walkable mix of medieval charm, modern art, and steep, scenic riverbanks along the Douro River.

Centrally located near Trindade Metro and S.Bento Station, Hotel Inca Porto offers spacious Inca styled rooms in the heart of Porto.

You can easily visit the town and nightlife on foot or using public transportation. The World Heritage Centre of Porto is 5 minutes' walk from the hotel.



Day 6 & 7

Tomar, Portugal

Tomar is one of Portugal's most underrated gems – a small city packed with history and charm set along the Rio Nabão. You can easily get a train from Tomar to Lisbon in under an hour. The old town is super walkable and boasts fantastic restaurants and bars. Local cuisine is exceptional and the local market showcases this.

Both Hotels in Tomar are excellently situated within the walls of Tomar and offer fantastic facilities. Both have a swimming pool and sun beds for the sun worshipers.

The Convent de Cristo is well worth a visit as it houses the earliest records of the Knights Templar. We will be spending 2 nights here and there will be a ride out planned for the middle day if you do want to ride out.



Day 8

Salamanca, Spain

Salamanca, a vibrant university city in northwestern Spain (Castile and León), is famed for its stunning golden sandstone architecture, UNESCO-listed old town, and one of Europe's oldest universities founded in 1218. Known as "La Dorada" (The Golden City), it offers a lively, walkable, and affordable atmosphere centered around the 18th-century Plaza Mayor

5-star Hotel in the heart of Salamanca, only 300m from the Main Square and boasts a small pool, sun terrace, hot tub and fitness suite.



Day 9

Burgos, Spain

Burgos is a historic city in northern Spain's Castile and León region, famous for its 13th-century Gothic cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and its role as a key stop on the Camino de Santiago pilgrimage. Known for its medieval architecture, rich gastronomy—especially morcilla (blood sausage)—and connection to the legend of El Cid, it is a significant cultural hub

This charming, colonial-style hotel is set within easy walking distance of Burgos' historic center and its impressive Cathedral, on one of the city's main avenues. Sights such as the Museum of Human Evolution and the Burgos Forum are all within a 20-minute walk. This grand hotel sports an elegant piano lounge bar, gourmet restaurant and classic rooms all with Wi-Fi.
