

Some estimated costs for Diagnostic Medical Imaging & Procedures:

Cost increases depending on several factors:

- Need for sedation or anesthesia
- Type of x-rays (regular versus the digital), number of views
- Type and location of facility providing services
- Type of disease and treatment protocols

CT scans \$500-\$1,200

MRI scans \$1,100-\$2,500 per session

XRays \$50-\$150, additional x-rays may range from \$20-\$75.

Cardiology

Initial consult \$150. Other recommendations such as, blood pressure, blood work, chest X-rays, electrocardiogram (ECG/EKG) or Holter monitor, will impact the cost of each visit. A typical cardiac work-up ranges from \$625 to \$1000, with an average cost of about \$800.

Dental

Oral exam, \$55-\$90, X-rays, \$125-\$250, Anesthesia, cleaning and extractions, \$600-\$1200

Dermatology

Initial consult \$300-\$450.

Estimates are provided from specialist after exam and prior to other procedures.

Oncology

Initial consult \$125-\$250.00. Chemotherapy ranges \$150-\$600.00 per dose depending on drug being used as oral or IV. Typically fees include all portions of the visit: recheck exam fee, blood work, chemo prep and administration costs, etc. but ask for details at time of call or visit. Radiation treatment ranges \$1000- \$1800 for a palliative protocol and about \$4500-6000 for a curative intent protocol. Surgical are highly dependent on tumor type and location.

Prosthetics - braces and prosthetics \$550-\$1,000

Rehabilitation / Therapy

Costs depend on pets' specific needs and course of therapy. Initial consult \$100-165. Follow-up visits vary based on services required; typically range from \$60-120.

Surgery - \$2,000-\$5,000

Ultrasound – For example the cost for an abdominal ultrasound is approximately \$300-\$350 with a general practice veterinarian and \$400-\$500 with a specialist.
