NOTICE OF LIEN OF JUDGMENT is hereby given and a Judgment Lien is hereby taken in favor of Nailah El Bey as Consul for and on behalf of Kia Aqeel El Bey (hereinafter "Lien Creditor") and against the property and assets of acting Sheriff Victor Bernard Hill, acting Chief Administrative clerk Wanda L. Dallas, acting Administrative clerk Jacqueline D. Wills, and acting District Attorney Tasha Mosley (hereinafter "Lien Debtors") for default and breach of constitutional

and treaty obligations under Article VI, clause 2 of the Constitution for the United States of North America, and under Articles 6 and 20 of the Treaty of Peace and Friendship of 1836 between the United States of North America and the Moroccan Empire, by failing to execute the duty in the Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Subjiciendum - Release Order which was duly served upon the Lien Debtors (principal and / or agent) on or about October 7, 2020, via United States Postmaster certified mail with return receipts (article numbers: 7019 0160 0000 4879 0886 for Jacqueline D. Wills; and 7019 0160 0000 4879 0879 for Victor Bernard Hill) for the purpose of enforcing such treaty obligations for the immediate release of the Lien Creditor from being denationalized and forcibly assimilated under the unconstitutional 14th Amendment U.S. corporate citizenship clause, while being held hostage for profit in unlawful imprisonment and involuntary servitude as surety for the fictitious corporate person / nom de guerre: CHARMAIN LILLIAN JACKSON, DOB: 11/02/1992, ID No.: 2133632 (race: black) under the custody of the Lien Debtor, Victor Bernard Hill, and there being no answer or cause to the contrary made by any of the Lien Debtors, it is therefore considered:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that a judgment lien be and the same is hereby entered against the Lien Debtors;

It is further ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that this judgment lien shall extend to and cover all property and all rights to property, real and personal, corporal and incorporeal, of the Lien Debtors and their spouse, their heirs, successors and assigns as long as this judgment lien is not fully satisfied, and the property and rights to property of the Lien Debtors, et al., shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following:

Any and all oaths of office, public surety bonds, lands, hereditaments, common property / community property, intellectual property, commercial property, automobiles, boats, aircrafts, bank accounts, future earnings, wages, and pensions;

It is further ORDERED AND ADJUGED that the said property of the Lien Debtors may be levy upon at any time by the Lien Creditor or by any consul agent of the Consulate General of Morocco at the Georgia state republic acting on behalf of and in the interest of the Lien Creditor, and such property shall be held as security until this judgment lien is fully satisfied;

It is further ORDERED AND ADJUGED that if this judgment lien is not fully satisfied by the Lien Debtors within thirty (30) days from the received date of this judgment lien by Lien Debtor, Jacqueline D. Wills, then the Lien Debtors forfeit all of their property and rights to property unto the Lien Creditor under this judgment lien in accordance with the organic 13th Amendment, section 12 of the Constitution for the United States of North America, which aver the following:

"The traffic in slaves with Africa is hereby forever prohibited on pain of death and the forfeiture of all the rights and property of persons engaged therein; and the descendants of Africans shall not be citizens."


It is further ORDERED AND ADJUGED that the acting Public Defender Adeline Alexander (hereinafter "Third Party Interloper") is notwithstanding in this case and does not under any circumstance represent the Lien Creditor or the nom de guerre CHARMAIN LILLIAN JACKSON, and the appearance of the Third Party Interloper is therefore void ab initio and stricken from this case along with any filings and attachments associated thereto.

- *Sniadach v. Family Finance Corp.*, 395 U.S. 337 349 (1968) (*"The ability to place a lien upon a man's property, such as to temporarily deprive him of its beneficial use, without any judicial determination of probable cause dates back not only to medieval England but also to Roman times."*)
