Upon the Affidavit In Support of the Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Subjiciendum [Exhibit: A] attached hereto and having been sworn to by our Sharif officer Adcel Bey before me this day, based upon the facts asserted therein, it is this 23rd day of November, 2020, hereby **ORDERED** that our Moorish American national Lamont Maurice El being detained under your custody on the information of LAMONT BUTLER, DOB: 05/15/1984, DPP#: 0416500A, SID: 3849414, DOC: 424942 (race: black), be forthwith **RELEASED** without condition or delay;

It is further **ORDERED** that the Sharif of the Morocco Consular Court at the Maryland state republic and his convoy shall enforce this writ, and the Secretary of (Maryland) State Police shall give aid or assistance to our Sharif and his convoy in the enforcement of this writ pursuant to the treaty obligations under Articles 4, 6, and 20 of the Treaty of Peace and Friendship of 1836 between the United States of North America and the Moroccan Empire;

It is further **ORDERED** that there shall be no cause for the delay in the execution of this writ.

I, Adeel Bey ("Affiant"), being of lawful age, and being first duly sworn upon affirmation, depose and say:

1. I am a Sharif and Mufti officer of the Consulate General of Morocco at the Maryland state republic. I was delegated authority by the Consul General to exercise the functions and duties of the Office of the Sharif under consular jurisdiction at the Maryland state republic, and to exercise such functions and duties in disputes affecting the person or property - estate of any Moorish American national inhabitant at the Maryland state republic with any foreign U.S. citizen - subject under the plausible 14th Amendment in accordance with the treaty obligations under the Treaty of Peace and Friendship of 1836 between the United States of North America and the Moroccan Empire.

2. I have first-hand knowledge and information of our Moorish American national Lamont Maurice El, also known and identified by his national identity card as Lamont Maurice Butler-El, is being presently denationalized and held hostage for profit as surety on the information of the fictitious name / nom de guerre LAMONT MAURICE BUTLER, DOB: 05/15/1984, DPP#: 0416500A, SID: 3849414, DOC: 424942 (Race: black) in unlawful imprisonment under the custody of the Commissioner and Chairman David R. Blumberg and his parole agent Bennie Spady at the following location:

3. Upon first-hand knowledge, I further assert that the unlawful imprisonment of our national Lamont Maurice El includes the following circumstances:
- a. On July 11, 2019, near corporate BALTIMORE, Maryland state republic, our national Lamont Maurice El was transferred from the physical custody of the Commissioner of the foreign corporate entity DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES (Inc.), to the custody of the foreign occidental European male David R. Blumberg, (acting as) Commissioner and Chairman of the private foreign de facto corporate entity MARYLAND PAROLE COMMISSION (Inc.) in accordance with the misrepresented instrument - bill of attainder / foreign bill of exchange titled Order for Release on Parole dated July 11, 2019, which was addressed to the fictitious name / nom de guerre LAMONT BUTLER (Race: black) within purview of the plausible 14th Amendment, and which our national Lamont Maurice El signed "Under Protest" and "Without Prejudice" to affirm the act against his will; to affirm the reservation of all of his rights; and to exonerate himself from any and all surety obligations in such instrument. The Order for Release on Parole instrument is notwithstanding, unconstitutional, null and void ab initio, and is unenforceable for fraud in the inducement. See attachment

EXHIBIT: A2 - copy of "page 3 of 4" of the Order for Release on Parole dated July 11, 2019 (where it shows "Evidence of protest and fraud in the inducement" and "Evidence of fictitious person and fraud" in red ink). Also see *United States v. Throckmorton*, 98 U.S. 61, 25 L.Ed. 93 (*"Fraud vitiates the most solemn contracts, documents, and even judgments."*).

- b. Our national **Lamont Maurice El** was compelled to sign the Order for Release on Parole instrument on July 11, 2019, under duress and coercion as a condition of him being released from the unlawful imprisonment and physical custody of the Commissioner of the DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES (Inc.) which was offered by Commissioner **David R. Blumberg** (et al.). **Lamont Maurice El**'s unlawful imprisonment resulted from him being kidnapped and held hostage for profit as surety under duress for the fictitious corporate person / nom de guerre **LAMONT MAURICE BUTLER** (Race: black) within purview of the unconstitutional 14th Amendment under the void bill of attainder / foreign bill of exchange styled as an 'administrative judgment' and a 'administrative sentence/order' filed in case number 08-K-13-000884 on April 9, 2014, in the records of the private foreign de facto corporate entity **CIRCUIT COURT FOR CHARLES COUNTY** (Inc.) by the collusion of two (2) foreign occidental European females name **Amy J. Bragunier** and **Sharon L. Hancock**, (both acting as) Administrative clerks of the same under color of law and in want of jurisdiction. The judgment and sentence are null and void ab initio and are unenforceable for lack of jurisdiction and fraud. See *Elliot v. Peirsol*, 26 U.S. 328, 340 (1828), (*"Courts are constituted by authority and they cannot act beyond the power delegated to them. If a court acts without authority, its judgments and orders are regarded as nullities. They are not voidable, but simply void; and form no bar to a remedy sought in opposition to them, even prior to a reversal. They constitute no justification; and all persons concerned in executing such judgments, or sentences, are considered, in law, as trespassers."*).

- c. Since July 11, 2019, our national **Lamont Maurice El** has been deprived of his liberty while being coerced to report to the 14th Amendment U.S. stateless person male **Bennie Spady**, (acting as) parole agent of the MARYLAND PAROLE COMMISSION (Inc.), and pay a monthly extortion fee to Commissioner **David R. Blumberg**, et al.
 - d. On January 31, 2020, the Affidavit of Rescission of Signature [Exhibit: J] with the attachments Exhibits: B1, B2, B3, F1, F2, K, K1, and K2, which were entered in case number 08-K-13-000884 and which rescind the signature of our national **Lamont Maurice El** on the Order for Release on Parole instrument dated July 11, 2019; and on February 3, 2020, Commissioner **David R. Blumberg** was duly served at his address by and through the assistant attorney general **Susan Howe Baron** with the Affidavit of Rescission of Signature [Exhibit: J] via United States Postmaster – Certified Mail with return receipt (Article No.: 7019 0160 0000 9724 8604). There was no cause to the contrary made to the Affidavit of Rescission of Signature [Exhibit: J] which stands in the record as conclusive evidence. See attachment **EXHIBIT: A1** – copy of United States Postmaster Certified Mail Receipt and Return Receipt.
 - e. On May 5, 2020, the Writ of Mandamus [Exhibit: L] with the attachments Exhibit: L1 and L2 was entered in case number 08-K-13-000884, and was served via United States Postmaster – Certified Mail with return receipts on or about the same date upon the Commissioner **David R. Blumberg** and the assistant attorney general **Susan Howe Baron**, which commanded for the immediate release of our national **Lamont Maurice El**. There was no cause to the contrary, and the writ was not executed which constitutes default and breach of duty. See Attachment **EXHIBIT: A3** – Copies of United States Postmaster Certified Mail Receipts and Return Receipts.
4. Our national **Lamont Maurice El** was not given access to consular jurisdiction in accordance with his treaty rights secured under the Treaty of Peace and Friend of 1836 between the United States of North America and the Moroccan Empire.

Friendship of 1836 between the United States of North America and the Moroccan Empire for the immediate release of our national Lamont Maurice El:

Article 4. A signal or pass shall be given to all vessels belonging to both parties, by which they are to be known when they meet at sea, and if the commander of a ship of war of either party shall have other ships under his convoy, the declaration of the commander shall alone be sufficient to exempt any of them from examination.

Article 6. (in relevant part) ...if any Moor, not a subject of these dominions, shall make prize of any of the citizens of America, or their effects, and bring them into any of the ports of his Majesty, they shall be immediately released, as they will then be considered as under his Majesty's protection.

Article 20. If any of the citizens of the United States, or any persons under their protection, shall have any disputes with each other, the Consul shall decide between the parties, and whenever the Consul shall require any aid or assistance from our government, to enforce his decisions, it shall be immediately granted to him.

6. The stare decisis law in the case *Kolovrat v. Oregon*, 366 U. S. 187, 194, 81 S.Ct. 922 (1961) ruled by the Supreme Court of the United States aver the following:

"A state cannot refuse to give foreign nationals their treaty rights because of fear that valid international agreements may possibly not work completely to the satisfaction of state authorities. Under the supremacy clause of the United States Constitution Art. VI, clause 2, state policies...must give way to overriding federal treaties and conflicting arrangements."

CONDITIONS OF PAROLE

1. Report as directed to and follow your Parole Agent's instructions.
2. Work regularly.
3. Get permission before:
 - a. Changing your home;
 - b. Changing your job; or
 - c. Leaving the State of Maryland.
4. Obey all laws.
5. Notify your Parole Agent immediately if you are arrested.
6. You shall not illegally possess, use, or sell any narcotic drug, "controlled dangerous substance", or related paraphernalia.
7. You shall not own, possess, use, sell, or have under your control any dangerous weapon or firearms of any description without approval of the Parole Commission.
8. You shall conduct yourself as not to present a danger to yourself or others.
9. Special conditions: See page 1 of this agreement.

NOTE: Conditions 10 and 11 apply to parolees whose term of confinement resulted from a crime or crimes committed on or after May 1, 1991.

10. You must pay a monthly supervision fee as required by law unless the Parole Commission exempts you wholly or partly from payment of the fee.
11. If ordered by the Parole Commission to undergo drug or alcohol abuse testing, you must pay for the testing if required to do so by the Division of Parole and Probation.

LB I have read, or have had read to me, the foregoing conditions of parole and any special conditions. I fully understand them and I agree, in consideration of granting of parole to observe and abide by such conditions of parole. Further, I hereby waive extradition to the state of Maryland and expressly agree that I will not contest any effort to return to the State of Maryland in consequence of my violating and of the terms and conditions of this parole.

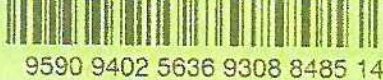

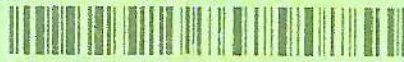
