#### CURACAO - INTRODUCTION

Curaçao, a Dutch Caribbean island, has become a prominent eGaming jurisdiction that attracts international operators due to its cost-effective licensing process and attractive tax regime. The Master License Holders are responsible for regulatory oversight, issuing a single license that covers all forms of online gaming and gambling.



#### **CURACAO - EGAMING HISTORY**

The history of eGaming in Curação dates back to the mid-1990s, when the island started issuing licenses for online gaming and gambling operators.

Today, Curação is a well-established hub for eGaming, with a substantial number of operators benefiting from the island's attractive tax regime, telecommunications infrastructure, and simple licensing process.


#### LEGAL FRAMEWORK

The primary legislation governing eGaming in Curaçao is the National Ordinance on Offshore Hazard Games (Landsverordening hazardspelen op afstand), which was enacted in 1993.



#### LICENSES

Single License System: Master License Holders offer a single eGaming sublicense that covers all forms of online gaming and gambling, including online casinos, sportsbooks, and poker rooms. Software providers can also receive B2B accreditation.

#### **CURACAO - PLAYER PROTECTION**

Player protection in Curação's eGaming industry is not as comprehensive as in some other jurisdictions. However, there are certain measures in place to safeguard players:


- 1. **Self-Regulation:** eGaming operators in Curação are expected to self-regulate and implement responsible gambling measures, such as providing players with tools to set deposit limits, self-exclude, and access information on responsible gambling.
- 2. Fair Gaming: Operators must ensure that their games are fair, transparent, and function according to industry standards. This involves engaging third-party testing agencies to audit and certify the fairness of games, including the use of random number generators.
- 3. Player Funds Segregation: Although not a legal requirement, some Curação-licensed operators choose to segregate player funds from operational funds as a best practice to ensure that player funds are protected in case of insolvency.

#### CURACAO - AML /CFT

Anti-Money Laundering (AML) and Countering Financing of Terrorism (CFT): Curação eGaming operators must adhere to international AML and CFT standards, implementing measures to prevent and detect money laundering and terrorist financing.





#### **CURACAO - DATA PROTECTION**

In Curação, data protection and privacy in the eGaming industry are governed by general data protection regulations that apply to all businesses operating on the island. Although there are no specific data protection regulations tailored to the eGaming sector, operators are responsible for ensuring customer privacy and data security.

#### Key aspects include:

- 1. **Privacy Policies:** eGaming operators must have clear and transparent privacy policies in place, outlining how they collect, process, store, and share players' personal data.
- 2. **Data Security Measures**: Operators are required to implement robust data security measures, such as encryption, firewalls, and secure authentication methods, to protect players' personal and financial information from unauthorized access, data breaches, and cyber threats.
- 3. **Data Retention and Deletion:** eGaming operators must adhere to data retention policies that comply with legal requirements, ensuring that players' personal data is not retained for longer than necessary.
- 4. **Data Processing Agreements:** When working with third-party service providers that process players' personal data on their behalf, operators must establish data processing agreements to ensure that these service providers also comply with relevant data protection regulations and maintain appropriate security measures.
- 5. International Data Transfers: If operators transfer players' personal data outside of Curaçao, they must ensure that such transfers comply with applicable data protection regulations and provide adequate safeguards to protect players' privacy rights.





#### MALTA - PLAYER PROTECTION

Player protection is a key aspect of Malta's online gambling regulations. The Malta Gaming Authority (MGA) is responsible for ensuring that licensed operators adhere to strict guidelines and measures to safeguard players' interests. Some of the primary player protection measures in place include:

- 1. Responsible Gaming: Operators are required to implement responsible gaming policies and practices, which include providing players with tools to manage their gambling behavior, such as self-exclusion options, deposit limits, and time limits. Operators must also display responsible gaming messages and provide information about support organisations that can assist with gambling-related issues.
- 2. **Fair Gaming:** Operators must use a Random Number Generator (RNG) for their games to ensure fair and unbiased outcomes. The RNG must be certified by an independent and accredited testing agency. Additionally, operators are required to display clear game rules and payout information.
- 3. Player Funds Protection: Licensed operators are required to hold player funds in a separate account from their operational funds. This segregation of funds helps protect players' balances in case the operator faces financial difficulties or insolvency.



#### MALTA - AML / CFT

Anti-Money Laundering (AML) and Combating the Financing of Terrorism (CFT) are essential components of Malta's online gambling regulatory framework. The Malta Gaming Authority (MGA) enforces strict guidelines and requirements for licensed operators to prevent money laundering and terrorist financing activities.





#### MALTA - DATA PROTECTION

Data Protection and Privacy: Operators must comply with data protection laws, such as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), to ensure the security and privacy of players' personal information. This includes implementing adequate technical and organisational measures to prevent unauthorised access, disclosure, or loss of data.
