

Let us be the RECORD KEEPER:

In Texas, private schools are not required to submit report cards, transcripts, standardized test scores, or other academic records to the state. Homeschools are considered private schools in Texas. Maintaining records can be tedious and may seem unnecessary. However, we highly recommend them.

The records to maintain will depend on the need. Some needs may include planning to:

- enter or re-enter a public school
- apply to a private school
- take dual-credit courses at a community college
- apply to college/university
- enlist in the military
- apply to a trade school or other training program

Let us keep the records of your child's success so that you can be assured he/she will be able to continue his/her education after homeschooling.

We will do the footwork to find out the requirements, if any, for any option your student is interested in, and prepare for all that your student may potentially do next. Most places will expect a simple transcript, perhaps with a brief description of each class; rarely will anyone ask to see report cards, tests, or completed worksheets, however we will have those in the event they are required.
