PTO Spirit Night



Academics for this Week

Phonics & Handwriting

This week we will focus on adding and deleting sounds in words. We will review letters we have learned and sounds.

Reading Workshop/Guided Reading

This week we will be reading a LOT of gingerbread stories! The kids will come into a surprise on Monday as we transform our hall into a gingerbread house! SHHHH...It's a secret! Please don't tell your child about the surprise!

Writing

We are learning what writers do! Writers:

- 1. Think
- 2. Draw
- 3. Label
- 4. Write

We are now learning that writers write sentences! Writers write sentences by:

- Sound out words by saying them slow like a turtle. Then write the sounds they hear.
- Put a finger space between each word
- Begin the sentence with an uppercase letter and end it with a period.

We will focus on opinion writing and discuss the difference between facts and opinions. We will talk about that an opinion is something we think or feel and that our opinions are personal and something we don't have to agree on.

Math

We started our addition topic this week and the kids are doing great with it! We've learned a few different strategies for help us add such as drawing pictures, counting pictures, using counters and our fingers. We will continue with addition next week as well.

Science

In science we are continuing with properties of matter.

Social Studies

In Social studies we will learn about holidays around the world and how other people celebrate the holidays. *Please let me know if there is a holiday other than Christmas that you celebrate!
