A veteran is a man or woman who has served in the US military.




# What is Veterans Day?


Veterans Day is a US holiday. On **Veterans** Day the men and women who have served in the US military are honored.



#### What is a poppy?


A poppy is a red flower that is a symbol of Veterans Day.

They do a very difficult job to help keep us safe.














