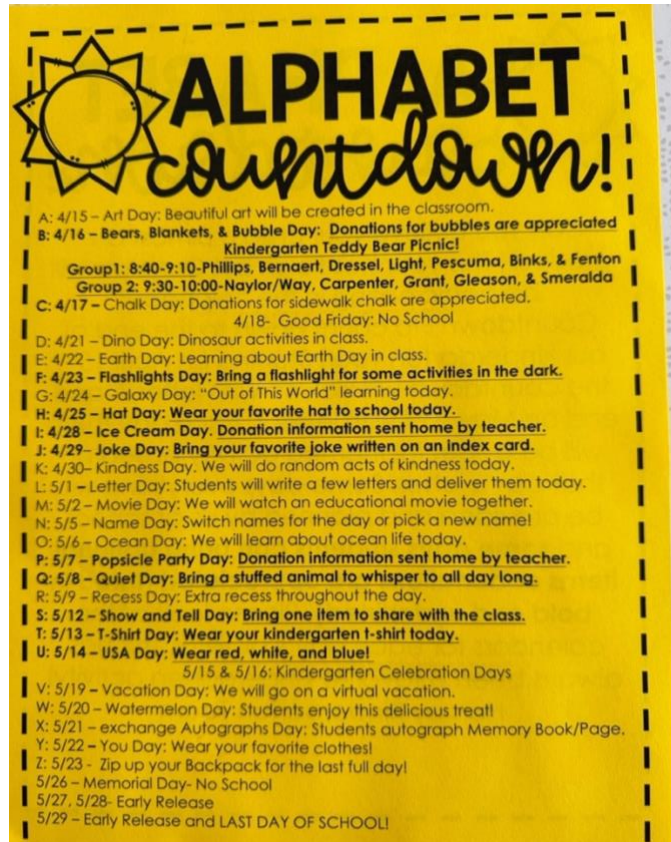
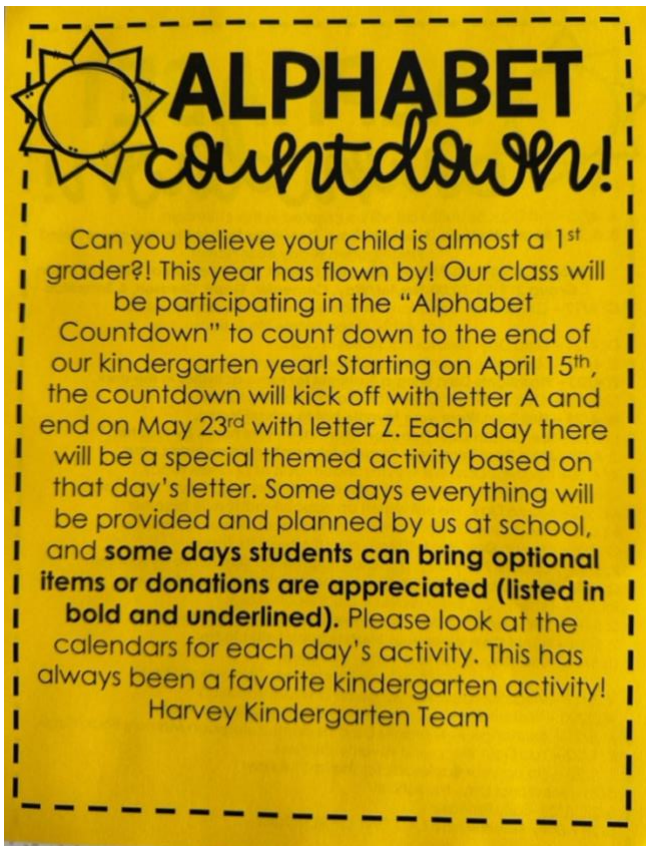

Important Details

Students should dress their best for the ceremony. Uniforms are not required.

Parking will be limited, and you will park in our car rider loop and the grass areas. Please leave the grass area in the bus loop for our guests with limited mobility. All other guests will follow the sidewalk next to the kindergarten playground, located towards the back section of our campus to enter the rear cafeteria doors.

Celebrations will begin promptly at their stated start time.

Each family will have one bench that seats approximately four adults. If your child has a sibling that attends Harvey, you will need to have that child arrive with you at the celebration. You will then sign that child in at the front office after the celebrations have concluded. We are not able to pull siblings from their classes.

After the ceremony, all families will exit the cafeteria to the covered outside area for pictures. At the conclusion of the celebration, you are welcome to sign out your child to celebrate the rest of the day together as a family. Please let your child's teacher know if you plan to do this, and there will be clipboards with sign out sheets in the picture area for you to sign. If your child is staying, please pack a change of clothes. To leave campus, you will exit to the parking lot through the middle of the building through the shark stairwell.

Academics for this Week

Phonics & Handwriting

we continue learning how to sound out CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words as well as build these words! We are learning how to identify the beginning, middle, and ending sounds! We are also learning about blends! A blend is two consonants together. We are learning blends with “l.” some words with blends include: sled, fled, glad, plan.

Reading Workshop/Guided Reading

Our reading stories will relate to our Alphabet Countdown themes.

Writing

Our writing will correspond with our reading and Alphabet Countdown. We will also start reviewing the correct letter formation. We will continue to:

1. Think
2. Draw
3. Label
4. Write

Writers write sentences by:

- Sound out words by saying them slow like a turtle. Then write the sounds they hear.
- Put a finger space between each word
- Begin the sentence with an uppercase letter and end it with a period.

Math

We will continue learning about measurement! You child will be able to use measure objects using nonstandard measurement.

Science/Social Studies

In Social studies we are working on being good citizens. We will continue our Science Fridays and learn about the life cycle of a plant and butterflies.
