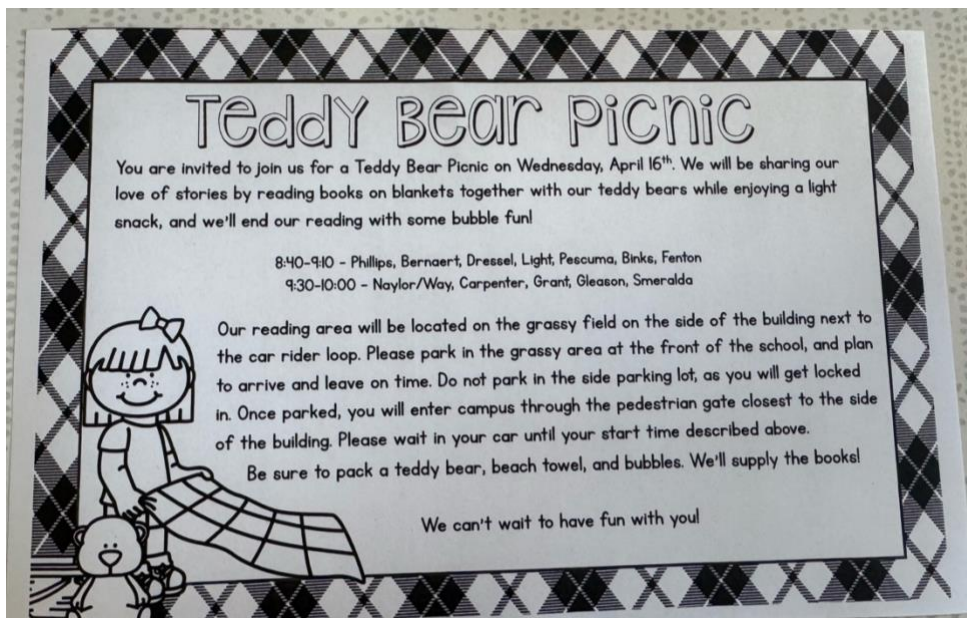

Academics for this Week

Phonics & Handwriting

we continue learning how to sound out CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words as well as build these words! We are learning how to identify the beginning, middle, and ending sounds! We are also learning about digraphs! Digraphs are sh, th, ch, and wh.

Reading Workshop/Guided Reading

We will continue with non-fiction stories and learn about plants! We will explore their life cycles, parts of plants, what they need and how they make food. While reading our stories we will focus on identifying the main topic and details from the story.

Writing

We are learning what writers do! Writers:

1. Think
2. Draw
3. Label
4. Write

We are now learning that writers write sentences! Writers write sentences by:

- Sound out words by saying them slow like a turtle. Then write the sounds they hear.
- Put a finger space between each word
- Begin the sentence with an uppercase letter and end it with a period.

We are continuing our work with personal narratives. We will focus on telling our stories in sequential order using transition words such as "first," "then," and "last."

Our writing will also tie in with our reading for the week and we will write about the lifecycle of plants!

Math

We will continue our 3D Shapes unit! First, we will review 2D shapes (circle, square, rectangle and triangle) and then we will explore 3D shapes (cones, cylinders, rectangular prisms, and spheres)

Science/Social Studies

In Social studies we are working on being good citizens. We will continue our Science Fridays and learn about the life cycle of a plants.
