Phonics & Handwriting

This week we will focus on adding and deleting sounds in words. We will learn how to write the letters Hh, Rr, Ll.

Reading Workshop/Guided Reading

We will start the week with a fiction story called Duck for President. We will vote on who would make a better president, Duck or the Farmer. We will end the week nonfiction Veterans' Day books and learn how to tell facts about Veteran's and Veteran's Day. We would love to celebrate the Veteran's in your family. Writing

We are learning what writers do! Writers:

1. Think
2. Draw
3. Label
4. Write

We are now learning that writers write sentences! Writers write sentences by:

- Sound out words by saying them slow like a turtle. Then write the sounds they hear.
- Put a finger space between each word
- Begin the sentence with an uppercase letter and end it with a period.

Math

This week we will model how to make numbers 6-10 on ten frames. We will also begin comparing numbers 6-10. Your child will be able to:

- Read, write, count, and make numbers 6-10
- Compare numbers 6-10 using the language "greater," "less," and "equal."
- Compare numbers 6-10 as objects and on a number line.

Science

In Science we will start our properties of matter unit and will be using pumpkins to explore properties of matter!

Social Studies

We continue to learn and talk about our Sharks Expectations, ways to problem solve, and be a Harvey Shark. We are beginning to learn about the calendar, months of the year, days of the week, and counting the days we have been in school. We will also incorporate Veteran's Day into our social studies learning.

Now that we are off our sugar rush from Halloween, I am excited to learn about Veteran's Day!
