Academics for this Week

Phonics & Handwriting

This week we are learning how to sound out CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words as well as build these words! We are learning how to identify the beginning, middle, and ending sounds!

Reading Workshop/Guided Reading

We will start our Author Study on Kevin Henkes. We will focus on our five-finger retelling (characters, setting, beginning, middle and end of the story).

Writing

We are learning what writers do! Writers:

1. Think
2. Draw
3. Label
4. Write

We are now learning that writers write sentences! Writers write sentences by:

- Sound out words by saying them slow like a turtle. Then write the sounds they hear.
- Put a finger space between each word
- Begin the sentence with an uppercase letter and end it with a period.

We are continuing our work with personal narratives. We will focus on telling our stories in sequential order using transition words such as "first," "then," and "last."

Our writing will also tie in with our reading for the week and we will write our opinion of the Kevin Henkes books we read.

Math

Soon we will begin our 3D Shapes unit! First, we will review 2D shapes (circle, square, rectangle and triangle) and then we will explore 3D shapes (cones, cylinders, rectangular prisms, and spheres)

Science/Social Studies

In Social studies we are working on being good citizens. We will start our Science Fridays again and learn about the life cycle of a butterfly.
