
Happy Sunday Shark Families! ABC Countdown begins this week! We are so excited to begin all the fun activities planned!


ABC Countdown Begins on Tuesday!

Reading Workshop/Guided Reading

On Monday we will read Easter stories and work on our five-finger retelling. Tuesday starts our Alphabet Countdown! Our reading lessons will relate to our Alphabet Countdown themes! This is the perfect opportunity to review all the reading skills we have worked on this year.

Writing

We are learning what writers do! Writers:

- 1. Think
- 2. Draw

- 3. Label
- 4. Write

We are now learning that writers write sentences! Writers write sentences by:

- Sound out words by saying them slow like a turtle. Then write the sounds they hear.
- Put a finger space between each word
- Begin the sentence with an uppercase letter and end it with a period.

We will be connecting our writing to ABC Countdown!

Math

We will be finishing up our 3D Shapes unit and then we will begin learning about measurement! You child will be able to use measure objects using nonstandard measurement.

Science/Social Studies

In Social studies we are working on being good citizens. We will continue our Science Fridays and learn about the life cycle of a plant and butteflies.
