CLUBS <u>KEYSTONE WOODS WMA GROUNDS</u>

RULES (4/15/25)

LEASE PERIOD APRIL 15TH-AUGUST 31ST, 2025

NO ACCESS TO GROUNDS <u>BEFORE 12:00PM Noon until June 1st.</u> NO BLANK OR LIVE AMMUNITION TO BE FIRED PRIOR TO 8AM.

- Know the boundaries and always stay in the designated training areas as outlined in the Lease. Non-Obvious Boundaries will be marked with Orange Fiberglass poles approximately every 100 feet. Reference the MAP.
- 2. Interactions with the PUBLIC must be dealt with cordially and respectfully. Explain that the area has been leased for dog training. Our lease is Non-Exclusive, which means that the PUBLIC has the right to be in our Lease areas at the same time we are if they choose to be. Avoid Conflicts!
- 3. LOCKED GATES: There will be locked gates we have permission to pass through that the Public does not. Lock them behind you. If you find a gate OPEN-LOCK IT! Locks must be connected "IN SEQUENCE" with any other locks on that gate so other stakeholders and DNR affiliated contractors can gain access as needed.
- 4. PARKING must be in the Public Parking Areas or our Non-Public Parking Areas which are enclosed with Black Silt Fencing. Highway Vehicles MUST be Parked INSIDE these Parking Areas. NO PARKING ON THE ROADWAYS. Close access when you leave.
- 5. ATVs are permitted during training following the lease guidelines. Maximum 2 PER AREA, must stay on established roads, 2 tracks, parking areas and inside mowed areas.
- 6. The lease has a provision that we will not cause any "soil disturbance". Use care and caution in that regard, especially after rains and avoid making ruts with highway vehicles and ATVs.
- 7. RESERVED VS OPEN TRAINING. <u>Check the Calendar</u> (MFFTC.com) and avoid conflicting with a Club's RESERVED Training Days and Areas. Each Club has been allotted a certain number of vehicle decal PASSES, they can issue to their members. OPEN TRAINING is allowed within the lease by a PASSHOLDER provided they do not interfere with a RESERVED Area/Day. Before engaging in OPEN Training, check the entire Area thoroughly to make sure someone else is not already there before letting dogs out. *Especially the Areas with multiple parking lots*.
- 8. The consumption of alcohol is prohibited on the grounds.
- 9. The use of non-toxic shot is required.
- One article of blaze orange clothing is required during upland training when live ammo is being used.

- 11. All trash, including spent shells and dead birds, must be removed from the grounds. Pick up any trash you find. Knock any mud and vegetation off vehicles/equipment to prevent the spread of invasive species.
- 12. When not being trained, trialed, or aired, dogs must be leashed, kenneled, or staked out.
- 13. Pigeons, Chukar, Bobwhite Quail, Mallard ducks and Pheasants may be released for dog training. **Ducks and Pheasants must have at least an 8-inch colored streamer attached to one leg** prior to release.

I have read, agree to and fully understand all the MFFTC rules governing dog training at the Keystone Woods W.M.A. leased training areas as well as appendix B of the lease and understand any violation of the rules or lease agreement will revoke my training pass. I also understand that I need to be a member in good standing of a MFFTC club.
