Rehearsals will be on Mondays and Thursdays. There will also be several Sunday rehearsals, which will be in lieu of a Monday rehearsal. The full rehearsal timetable will be available soon.

On performance days and the Sundays following, it is expected all cast and crew make themselves available to assist with setup and pack up, particularly the last Sunday. Many hands make light work.

Club Details and Expectations

All cast and crew are to be financial members of the Williams Repertory Club.

The membership fee is \$20 per person and payable at the first rehearsal. EFT or cash acceptable, the Treasurer will have forms to complete and sign which will have the banking details.

The cast may need to supply some of their own costumes, for example, jeans, white T-shirts, sneakers/shoes, pantyhose etc. Where costumes are to be made, the club will be responsible for supplying these.

Cast members normally supply their own makeup, however the club does have a small quantity of makeup available to use.

Character Roles

Danny Zuko

Danny is the leader of the Burger Palace Boys. He is charismatic and confident, with a sense of easy-going charm.

Sandy Dumbrowski

Sandy is Danny's love interest. She is sweet, wholesome, naïve, and cute, like Sandra Dee of the Gidget movies.

THE PINK LADIES

The club-jacketed, gum-chewing, hip-swinging girls' gang that hangs around with the Burger Palace Boys. A group of misfits who have found each other and established their own clique.

Rizzo

Leader of the Pink Ladies. She is tough, sarcastic and outspoken but vulnerable.

Jan

A compulsive eater. Jan is loud and pushy with the girls, but shy and uncomfortable with boys.

Marty

The "beauty" of the Pink Ladies. Looks older than the other girls but betrays her age when she opens her mouth. Tries to act sophisticated.

Frenchy

A dreamer. Good natured and dumb. Heavily made-up, fussy about her appearance – particularly her hair. She can't wait to finish high school so she can be a beautician.

THE BURGER PALACE BOYS

A super-cool, hard-looking group of high school wheeler-dealers...or so they think.

Kenickie

Second-in-command of the Burger Palace Boys. Tough looking, tattooed, surly, avoids any show of softness. Has an off-beat sense of humour.

VOCAL RANGE: Baritone

Roger

Roger is the anything-for-a-laugh stocky type. Full of mischief, half-baked schemes and ideas. A clown who enjoys putting other people on.

VOCAL RANGE: Tenor

Doody

Youngest of the guys. Small, boyish, open, with a disarming smile and a hero-worshipping attitude toward the other guys. Plays guitar onstage.

VOCAL RANGE: Tenor

Sonny

Sonny is an Italian-looking guy, with shiny black hair and dark, oily skin. He is a braggart and wheeler-dealer who thinks he's a real lady-killer but is completely tone deaf to most people around him.

No solo singing

OTHER ROLES

Patty

A typical cheerleader. She is aggressive, sure of herself and given to bursts of disconcerting enthusiasm. Catty, but in an All-American girl sort of way. Patty is a strong mover who can twirl a baton.

VOCAL RANGE: Alto

Cha-Cha

A blind date. Slovenly, loud-mouthed, and homely. Cha-Cha takes pride in being the best dancer at St. Bernadette's.

Non-singing role

Eugene

The class valedictorian. Physically and socially awkward, with weak eyes and a high-pitched voice. An apple-polisher, smug, and pompous but gullible.

Non-singing role

Johnny Casino

A veteran greaser and former student at Rydell. A local rock 'n' roll icon in the making.

Teen Angel

A cameo role as Frenchie's guardian angel

Vince Fontaine

A typical "teen audience" radio disc jockey. Slick, egotistical, fast talking. A veteran "greaser".

Miss Lynch

An old maid English teacher

You may also be asked to read extracts from the script.


All people auditioning should be prepared to attend a vocal and dance audition.
