NCEON Newsletter – January 2021

Dear NCEON Supporters and Volunteers –

NCEON STATS

The following food distributions were made during the months of October-December 2020. Please note the food items that we share with other ministries are perishable items that are left over and cannot be used at NCEON. All shelf items are retained for our NCEON community:

October 2020

1. Bags of Food - Families - 515 x \$30 = \$15,450.00
 2. Bags of Food – Hands & Feet for Jesus - 280 x \$30 = \$8,400.00
 3. Bags of Food – Lutheran Mission – 50 x 30 = \$1,500.00
 4. Bags of Food – Catholic Charities - 21 x 30 = \$630.00
 5. Bags of Food – Way Homes – 70 x 30 = \$2100.00

Total Value of Food Bags Distributed - 637 x \$30 = \$23,910.00

Expenses for 2020:

NCEON's total combined operating expenses for 2020 was \$29,727.00 as compared to 2019 which was \$33,824.00. These expenses include rent, BGE, Verizon (phone and internet), water & sewage, pest control service, trash & recycling removal, and miscellaneous expenses for various office supplies.

Due to COVID-19 hitting so early in the year and our assistance was reduced to food assistance only, our total monetary distribution to our clients was \$9,801.00, last year it was \$82,710.00. We resumed financial assistance on January 18, 2021.

NCEON has been blessed by the generosity of many churches, organizations and loving people that continue to support us both financially and with food donations. We are so appreciative of this gesture of continued support to our community. Below is a comparison of our cash donations for the last two years. Even with the COVID-19 pandemic, our monetary donations received during 2020 was on par with 2019. The donations in 2020 were within 2% of the 2019 donations.

- Financial Donations - Jan-Dec 2019 – \$134,764.00

NCEON SERVICES UPDATE

NCEON resumed financial assistance for our community on January 18, 2021 on Monday's and Wednesday's, beginning on February 5 will include Fridays for financial assistance as well. Financial assistance interviews are set-up by prior appointment and the interview process is handled by telephone in order to practice a no-contact environment for the safety of both our volunteers and clients. **Appointments can be made by contacting NCEON at 410-766-1826.**

During the month of February NCEON will be open on Tuesday's for food assistance during the hours of 10:00 to 1:00 PM.

NCEON UPDATES

During the month of December, NCEON was fortunate enough to receive an abundance of both food and monetary donations. Due to the health of our finances, we are increasing our assistance amount from \$150.00 to \$250.00-\$300.00

We continue to allow clients to receive food assistance on a monthly vs. quarterly basis. The increased frequency of distribution will continue for as long as we are experiencing the pandemic.

During our January 20, 2021 Board meeting, both Jan Murphy, NCEON President and Dianne Tabor, NCEON Treasurer announced that they will retire from their NCEON offices at the end of 2021. A committee has been formed to plan a special event to recognize them for their years of service to NCEON. We will be working this in compliance with COVID-19 protocols.
