Expenses for the 2019 calendar year:

Our total combined expenses for 2019 was approximately: \$24,500. These expenses included rent, BGE, Verizon (phone and internet), water & sewage, pest control service, trash and recycling removal and miscellaneous reimbursements for various office supplies.

Total cash donations for the year of 2019 was: \$123,538.16.

Total bags of groceries donated for the year of 2019 was 9,287, with a cash value of \$278,000.

The 2019 combined total of cash and food donations was \$401,538.16.

Also, due to the generosity of our donors, NCEON was able to adopt a family with five children for Christmas. We provided them with gifts for each of the children as well as a Christmas dinner food basket.

Over the entire holiday season NCEON had the privilege to be a blessing to many unfortunate families that were in severe need of food baskets for a holiday meal. Due to our volunteer's involvement we were able to provide both Thanksgiving and Christmas dinner food baskets to families that were experiencing unfortunate conditions.

We express our continued appreciation to our many donors, large and small for their support of both cash and food contributions. It would not be possible for NCEON to aid those in need in the community without your partnership with us. Thank you for your support and compassion in helping families in need in our community.
