#### NCEON STATS

The following food and financial distributions were made during the month of March 2021. Please note the food items that we share with other ministries are perishable items that are left over and cannot be used at NCEON. All donated shelf items are retained at NCEON for distribution to our local community:

#### March 2021

1. BGE - \$600.00
2. Eviction - \$250.00
3. Utilities: \$300.00
4. Bags of Food - Families – 339 x \$30 = \$10,170.00
5. Bags of Food – Hands & Feet for Jesus - 218 x \$30 = \$6,450.00
6. Bags of Food – BWMC – 56 x 30 = \$1680.00
7. Total number of families served – 58
8. Total number of people served – 142

**Total Value of Food Bags Distributed – x \$30 = \$18,390.00**
