EXPENSES FOR JANUARY AND FEBRUARY 2020:

Our total combined expenses for the months of January and February 2020 were \$6,432.97. These expenses include rent, BGE, Verizon (phone and internet), water & sewage, pest control service, trash & recycling removal and miscellaneous reimbursements for various office supplies.

In comparing our donations during the Jan-Feb 2020 with Jan-Feb 2019, our donations are down by \$10,829.83.

FOOD SUPPLIES

Our food donations have been very healthy over the last two months, we thank our devoted contributors for remembering NCEON and serving our community through your generosity.

We were recently blessed to receive a supply of hams from an anonymous donor which we were able to distribute to various helping up organizations that serve our community.

We also had the good fortunate to receive a large donation of chickens from Giant Food in Easton, MD. We feel fortunate to be able to offer chicken along with non-perishable food items to our clients.

PARTNERSHIPS

We're often been blessed with many perishable food items on Fridays in which we often have a larger supply than demand. We are pleased to be able to share these extra supplies with the organizations that participate in Saturday morning feeding ministry located at the Brewsters parking lot. These ministries include Be Kind, Hands and Feet for Jesus and several other organizations that have a passion to minister to those in need in our community.

We recently were able to support one of our partner churches during their week of holding Winter Relief. We provided them with snack food items, baked goods and various toiletries. The Winter Relief program is managed by the Arundel House of Hope which partners with local churches that take turns allowing homeless individuals to sleep and receive meals at participating churches.
