Expenses for March and April 2020:

Our total combined expenses for the months of March and April 2020 were \$4,153.83. These expenses include rent, BGE, Verizon (phone and internet), water & sewage, pest control service, trash & recycling removal, and miscellaneous reimbursements for various office supplies.

During these austere financial times that so many people are experiencing, NCEON continues to be blessed by the generosity of many churches, organizations and loving people that continue to support us both financially and with food donations. We are so appreciative of this gesture of continuous support to our community. Below snapshot of our cash donations and operating expenses so far this year.

NCEON SERVICES UPDATE

After a brief shutdown, NCEON has reopened our doors again to serve our community with food assistance. A sign-up sheet procedure has been implemented to allow us to process food requests from our clients. We initially reopened with limited hours from 10 AM to 1 PM. Last week we resumed our regular operating schedule of M-W-F, 10 AM to 2 PM. Due to social distancing requirements, only 10 volunteers are allowed in the building.

During the time of our closure we had our facility sanitized from top to bottom. At the present time no clients are allowed in the building.

During this time of crisis, NCEON has increased the frequency of food distribution from quarterly to monthly. We understand that these are extraordinarily difficult times and we want to help alleviate hunger in our community to the best of our ability.

Currently we are working on a plan to resume monetary assistance. This plan will be implemented as soon as the restrictions are lifted. The plan will include but not be limited to the number of clients in the building. A

protective screen will be installed around the desks the volunteers use during the interview process.

We recently mailed out two letters, one to our volunteers informing them of how we are currently operating. The second letter went out to our giving partners to update them on our operating procedures and available services.

We are in the process of composing another letter to mail to our volunteers that interview clients to explain the procedures that will be in place for everyone's protection. Their safety is our foremost concern.

VOLUNTEERS

We have been fortunate to have three more people join NCEON as volunteers as a result of them having more free time due to their temporary employment furlough. We will lose them once they return to work, but we are happy to have them while they are available.

Just a reminder, NCEON always welcomes those who wish to volunteer that are able and willing to help with the pick-up of food from local vendors (Giant, The Bread Man, BJ's, Chick fil-a, WaWa).

FOOD SUPPLIES

Thank you to our partners who faithfully donate food and funds that allow us to support the needs of our community.
