**NCEON Newsletter – August 2020**

Dear NCEON Supporters and Volunteers –

**NCEON STATS**

Due to social distancing during the months of May, June and July, we limited our assistance to food distribution only. We did not provide financial support for BGE, eviction, medical, utilities or special cases.

The following food distributions were made during the months of May, June and July 2020:

**May 2020**

1. Bags of Food - Families - 262 x \$30 = \$7,860.00
2. Bags of Food – Catholic Charities 50 x \$30 = \$1,500.00
3. Bags of Food – Way Homes – 135 x 30 = \$4,050.00
4. Bags of Food – Lutheran Mission – 30 x 30 = \$900.00
5. Bags of Food – Methodist Outreach – 10 x 30 = \$300.00
6. Bags of Food – Glen Burnie Home – 40 x 30 = \$1,200.00
7. Total number of families served - 76

**June 2020**

### Expenses for May, June and July 2020:

Our total combined expenses for the months of May, June and July 2020 were \$9,327.78. These expenses included rent, BGE, Verizon (phone and internet), water & sewage, pest control service, trash & recycling removal, insurance and miscellaneous expenses for various office supplies. We also had the additional expense of the plexiglass purchase, masks, face shields and gloves. The plexiglass will be installed at the front desk and interviewers' desks.

NCEON has been blessed by the generosity of many churches, organizations and loving people that continue to support us both financially and with food donations. We are so appreciative of this gesture of steadfast support to our community. Below is a snapshot of our cash donations and operating expenses so far this year.

- Financial Donations - Jan-July 2020 – \$46,605.25
- Operating Expenses Jan-July 2020 – \$20,405.64

### NCEON SERVICES UPDATE

NCEON continues to operate on a limited basis, we are providing food assistance only since we are able to support people with food their needs from outdoors. We are open during our normal schedule of M-W-F, 10 AM to 2 PM. We are still limiting the number of volunteers to 10.

We are still providing increased frequency of food distribution from quarterly to monthly. We continue to give food to anyone in need, regardless of whether or not they live in north Anne Arundel county. We have an abundance of

food and want to bless those in need without any limitations. We want to help alleviate hunger in our community to the best of our ability.

We have come up with a plan to be put in place for when we open up to offer full services. The plan will include but not be limited to the number of clients in the building. A protective screen will be installed around the desks the volunteers use during the interview process. Once the spread of COVID-19 begins to decline we will determine a date to reopen.

## **VOLUNTEERS**

Due to the reopening of government offices we lost our temporary volunteers that were helping with the pick-up of food donations. We are appreciative for their dedication and efforts during the time they were available to help out.

As a reminder, NCEON always welcomes those who wish to volunteer that are able to help with the pick-up of food from local vendors (Giant, The Bread Man, BJ's, Chick fil-a, WaWa).

## **BOARD MEETING**

For our NCEON board members – we will finally hold a meeting on Wednesday, August 19 at 7:00 PM in the Church of God community center. We are limiting attendance to one representative per church so that we are able to maintain social distancing guidelines. We can accommodate a total of sixteen representatives, therefore we ask that you RSVP so that we can ensure that we do not exceed that number.
