Gerry delighted in visits from his grandchildren. Gerry was born in Cincinnati on July 19, 1944 to Frank and Virginia Albers. He was a graduate of St. Xavier High School ('61) and received his Bachelor's and Master's in Engineering from the University of Detroit ('67) and Doctorate in 1969. He served as an officer in the U.S. Air Force, serving in Vietnam flying the F-5 Phantom and as a T-38 flight instructor.

After teaching Advanced Engineering at the University of Dayton he enjoyed a successful business career at General Electric in the Aircraft Engine Division. He was an entrepreneur, owning his own business, Process Automation, before retiring in 2008. He always said that he had done everything but run for public office. In retirement he received many accolades and awards for designing and building a world-renowned model railroad, which fulfilled a lifelong dream.
