January	FREIGHT CARS – Any car found in a freight train - REVISED December 15, 2013	<b>MOW EQUIPMENT</b> – <u>M</u> aintenance <u>of W</u> ay
February	CABOOSES	CABOOSES
March	No Contest (Flea Market)	No Contest (Flea Market)
April	<b>DIORAMA (On Line)</b> - NOT in False Front Format - "On Line Diorama" has structure/s OWNED BY or SERVICED BY a railroad	<b>TRAINS Approaching GRADE CROSSING/S</b> - You must show a power unit and the crossing signal/s
May	No Contest (Bus Trip)	No Contest (Bus Trip)
June	<b>ON-LINE THIN-LINE STRUCTURE/S</b> (False Front/Backdrop) - NOT in Diorama format - You must provide support for your structure/s - "On- Line Structure/s" is ANY structure/s OWNED BY or SERVICED BY a railroad.	<b>SWITCH MACHINES</b> - If Automatic, show the "Control Box"; if Manual, show the Lever
July	<b>SERVICING FACILITIES</b> - Examples: Repair Shops, Roundhouses, Sanding Facilities, Coaling Towers, Water Towers, Ash Pits, etc.	<b>RAILROAD STRUCTURE/S</b> - This means ANY Structure found on a railroad and/or OWNED by a railroad - This would be similar to an "On-Line structure" in the "Model" category
August	<b>PASSENGER CARS</b> – Any car found in a passenger train	PERSONNEL WORKIN' ON THE RAILROAD
September	MOW EQUIPMENT – <u>Maintenance of Way</u> - <u>REVISED December 15, 2013</u>	<b>MID-CENTRAL REGION LAYOUTS</b> - Photographer can by ANY NMRA member entering this competition, the print MUST be of a Mid-Central region member's layout - Give credit to the owner of the layout on a small slip of paper below the print entry
October	<b>BRING–N–BRAG OFF-LINE STRUCTURES</b> - "Off-Line Structure" is ANY structure NOT OWNED BY a railroad or NOT SITTING ON TRACKAGE of ANY railroad line	WEATHERED/DAMAGED FREIGHT CARS
November	<b>RR VEHICLES</b> - This can be ANY vehicle found on a railroad that has a sign designating it as being OWNED BY a railroad, but is NOT considered to be ROLLING STOCK (such as a Locomotive, Passenger Car or Freight Car) - Examples: BNSF Highrailer, Baltimore & Ohio Panel Truck, Union Pacific Tractor Trailer Delivery Truck, etc.	RAILROAD BRIDGE/S without Trains - Just show the bridge/s
December	ANYTHING GOES - Obviously, RAILROAD related	<b>LOCOMOTIVES</b> – Diesel or Steam locomotives or any other powered railroad unit (Electrics, etc.)
