John (Jack) G. Laubisch II, of Pierce Township, Ohio, passed away on April 30, 2025, at the age of 83. Jack was born in Rowan Co., Kentucky, on March 21, 1942, to the late John Grant and Mamie Laubisch. Jack is survived by his loving life partner Shirley Coffey, his beloved rescue hound Darwin, his “adopted” son Scott Spradlin and his wife Sigrid.
