FIRST NEW RANGE: Our new range is operational! Called the "Pistol Range" it's a 10-position covered bench area extending to 50 yards. This range was designed primarily as a pistol range with shooters shooting in the standing position but a few chairs are available at the range and the range is not limited to just pistols, any firearm may be used on the range the only limitation is 50 yards. Shooters may park in the turnaround area at the entrance to the club property the walk down the pathway or drive down the driveway past the maintenance buildings. Please be courteous to others shooters and not block their vehicles. The same rules apply to the new "Pistol Range" as on the original "Rifle Range.

SECOND NEW RANGE: Plans are in the works for a 500-yard rifle range. Originally, we were planning a 600-yard range which was to make use of the Constitution Pipelines "Access Road". After cancellation of the pipeline project, we were forced to re-evaluate. We are considering a covered bench area below the trap pavilion on field 3 and shooting over the pond to 500 yards. More information will come when it's available.

WHO WOULD HAVE THOUGHT: Beginning with Gilbertsville-Mt. Upton Central School, several high schools in the area have established a high school trap team. GMU, Laurens, Schenevus/Worcester, Milford, Cherry Valley, Richfield Springs and Walton so far, have been approved by their respective school boards to participate in this postal league. A few other schools have expressed interest too. Laurens and Walton teams are shooting once a week for 6 weeks at OSC from mid-April to the end of May. We hope this catches on, as the younger generation is the future of our sport.
