

GROVE PARK JUNIOR GOLF CLINIC, INC.

ORIENTATION & RULES

(Parents should cover this information with your child)

1. There will be four separate age groups: 5-9, 10-11, 12-13, and 14 and older.
2. Girls and boys will be assigned to the same class.
3. All students are expected to perform golf-related exercises before class begins. An instructor will lead the exercise activity.
4. Orientation for students will be done in small groups:
5. **Safety First: No running, no throwing of any object, no horseplay, be aware of your surroundings, stay away from ditches, use caution when crossing the street, obey instructors and golf course professionals, keep the golf course and clubhouse clean.**
6. Students will participate in activities based on the following requirements:

7. **Dress Code: All participants must wear proper attire during Summer Clinic. Juniors are permitted to wear shorts. The length must be within three inches from the top of the knee (i.e. Walking Shorts). Proper hygiene is requested of all participants. All participants should wear athletic supported garments and a cap, hat or sun visor.**
8. **Clothing not permitted during Summer Clinic: Short Shorts, Tennis Shorts, Gym Shorts, Cut-off Shorts, Blue Jean Shorts, T-shirts or Caps with Bibb facing backward.**
9. **Registration cut-off will be June 1st, unless parent has notified GPJGC in advance why the child cannot attend the first week.** There will be a requirement to come early or stay late to catch up with the other students.
10. All students must retrieve golf balls after hitting in their group.
11. Profanity, fighting and smoking are prohibited and will not be tolerated.
12. Violations of any of the rules will be handled in the following ways at the discretion of the instructor/coach, director and/or assistant director:
 - Verbal or written warning to the golfer/student and/or the parent;
 - Directed to pick up paper and rake sand traps for 30 days;
 - Suspension of golfer from the Summer Clinic.
