




WV Dog Tax Information

West Virginia requires a yearly license fee (head tax) for dogs over six months old, collected by the county assessor. The fee is at least \$3 per dog, with some municipalities adding an extra city fee. Owners must register their dogs and provide their age, sex, color, and breed to receive a registration tag. Service and guide dogs are exempt from the tax but still require registration. Contact the Roane County Assessor's Office at (304) 927-3020 for more information.





It may also be beneficial to have a list of symptoms and a general timeline of when you began experiencing them and their severity. If you have previous mental health treatment history, those records may be requested from previous providers.




