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Program Feature: Don't Be Rude – Where Respect Begins

We are thrilled to welcome our **Y.O.U. participants in the ST. Lukes Foot Print**, who will serve as **program coordinators beginning June 16, 2025**. Their leadership will help launch this summer's **Don't Be Rude** program sessions, which officially begin **July 1, 2025**, as part of our intergenerational initiative.

The **Don't Be Rude** program is designed to nurture positive behaviors and social-emotional development in children. Through lessons in manners, etiquette, and emotional intelligence, we equip youth with the tools to thrive in school, family, and community life. Our culturally inclusive approach helps children from all backgrounds understand the power of gratitude, empathy, and kindness.

Why It Matters

Children who build strong social-emotional skills are **54% more likely to graduate high school** and **46% more likely to hold full-time jobs** by age 25 (Committee for Children).

We're Gearing Up for Summer Camp!

Final plans are underway for our Don't Be Rude Summer Sessions, launching in July. Campers will:

- **Learn table manners** and social etiquette, culminating in an upscale etiquette dinner to practice what they've learned in a formal setting
- **Enjoy an interactive puppet show** that models respectful behavior and teaches problem-solving skills in a fun, age-appropriate way
- **Participate in creative activities and games** that reinforce core values like gratitude, generosity, and consideration

YASS Program Impact -

In May, we took bold steps to empower our young adults through dynamic engagements:

At Harvey Rice Library,

We hosted a **Workforce Development Workshop** where participants built resumes, practiced interview techniques, and completed career interest assessments. Each young adult left with a personalized career packet and access to job leads, training referrals, and clothing vouchers for interview attire.

At Zanzibar Soul Fusion,

Our **Professional Networking Mixer** brought together young adults with entrepreneurs, community leaders, and program alumni. This intimate setting gave participants the chance to share their aspirations, receive mentorship, and build connections in a real-world environment.

Additionally, we **participated in two career fairs within the St. Luke's footprint**, reaching our target audience of young adults in neighborhoods that need access to opportunity the most. These events helped expand awareness of our services and connected us directly with job seekers ready to take the next step.

Impact Highlights:

- 12 participants received job interviews within one week of the workshop
- 9 applied for training programs through community partners.
- 100% of attendees reported increased confidence in their communication and job-seeking skills
