Feature Segment: Don't Be Rude -Where Respect Starts Young

The Don't Be Rude program is designed to instill positive behavioral habits and social-emotional skills in children through lessons in manners, etiquette, and emotional intelligence. Using a culturally inclusive approach, we work with children from diverse backgrounds to help them understand the value of gratitude, consideration, and kindness in everyday life.

- Workshops are available in both in-person and virtual formats.
- Programming aligns with CASEL standards for social-emotional development. 91% of parents surveyed said their child became more mindful and respectful after attending two or more sessions.

Why It Matters

Children with strong social-emotional skills are 54% more likely to graduate high school and 46% more likely to hold full-time employment by age 25 (source: Committee for Children).

Our book Don't Be Rude continues to be used as a central tool in each session, sparking conversations that bridge generations and create deeper connections within families.

We're Gearing Up for **Summer Camp!**

We are finalizing plans for our Don't Be Rude Summer Sessions, launching in July. Campers will:

- Participate in hands-on social skills lessons
- Focused on teamwork and service
- Engage in creative projects centered around kindness and leadership
- 86% of parents from last year's camp said their child returned to school more confident and focused.
