

# 5 Steps to Hauling Containers CHECKLIST

## STEP 1: APPLY FOR YOUR TWIC CARD

**a. Complete Online Enrollment Application**

**Website:** <https://www.tsa.gov/twic>

**b. Schedule In-Person Appointment**

At the end of the enrollment application, you will be prompted to schedule an appointment at a location near you to provide identification documents.

*Make sure you bring the required documents!*

**c. Receive TWIC Card in the mail**

It typically takes 21 to 30 days for your TWIC card to arrive in the mail.

## STEP 2: REGISTER FOR A SCAC CODE

**a. Complete Online Registration**

**Website:** <https://scaccode.com/apply-new-scac/carrier>

**b. Save your SCAC Certificate:**

You will receive your new SCAC code immediately after paying the annual fee.

Save the SCAC Certificate for your records.

## STEP 3: REGISTER WITH UIIA

### a. Complete Online Registration

Website: <https://intermodal.org/uiia/motor-carriers-apply-uiia-participation>

### b. Submit Insurance to UIIA

Once registered, you will receive an email from UIIA containing your Insurance Company Code. Provide the Insurance Company Code to your insurance agent. The agent will use this code to submit your insurance details to UIIA.

### c. Add Drivers to Driver Database

### d. Print out Approved Equipment Provider List

## Step 4: CCM Shipments (Chassis Pool)

### a. Complete Online Registration

### b. Register with Chassis Providers

You must register with at least one (1) chassis provider to participate in the Chassis Pool.
