Directors Report (11/6/2023)

Administration

- 1) Due to personal reasons (pregnancy) our Controller, Billie Crabtree, has resigned. We have hired Diane Street to take her place.
- 2) New 2024 Budget for \$603,457 was approved by County Council on 10/16. This amount was within our assigned DLGF Levy.
- 3) Tire Day on September 22nd took in 24 tons of tires and rims for recycle.
- 4) Dumpster Day on September 8th netted 5 tons of trash.
- 5) YTD tonnage is at
- 6) Cardboard pricing is currently at \$65/ton which is good however most everything else has decreased in price. Cardboard represents 52% of our total intake.
- 7) The RC has applied for an IDEM sweetheart grant with a 75%/25% match. If awarded, the monies will be used to purchase of an additional large recycle container.
- 8) Trash revenues YTD stand at \$16,098 with net profit of \$10,985.

IC 36-1-8-11.5 Payment of claims; electronic fund transfer

Sec. 11.5 (a) As used in this section, "electronic funds transfer" means any transfer of funds, other than a transaction originated by check, draft, or similar paper instrument, that is initiated through an electronic terminal, telephones, or magnetic tape for the purpose of ordering, instructing or authorizing a financial institution to debit or credit an account.

- (b) The body of a political subdivision or board of a municipally owned utility may adopt a resolution to authorize an electronic fund transfer method of payment of claims. If a proper body adopts a resolution under the subsection, the political subdivision or municipally owned utility may pay money from its fund by electronic funds transfer.
- (c) A political subdivision or municipally owned utility that pays a claim by electronic funds transfer shall comply with all other requirements for the payment of claims by political subdivisions or municipal utilities.
