The **Adopt-A-Road Program** is a litterreduction campaign designed to remove litter debris from county roads and improve the quality of the environment.

What are the requirements??

- Adopt at least a one mile stretch of road, & commit to keeping it litter free for two years or more.
- · Pick up litter at least 4 times per year
- Responsible individuals are
 Encouraged to be part of the clean
 Up crew.

Children under age 12 are not permitted to participate for safety reasons

How Do I Adopt-A-Road

You've already taken the first step by expressing your interest in the Adopt-A-Road Program. If you decide you would like to participate, your next step is to fill out the registration form. Return it to the Solid Waste District at your earliest convenience—make sure to include the name of the road that you wish to adopt, the beginning and ending points, and the number of miles (a one mile minimum, please!). You will receive a safety guideline and checklist.

As a Volunteer, you will receive:

- Guidance and support for successful cleanups
- A safety guideline
- Safety vests, gloves, trash bags
- The opportunity to positively impact your community
- An "Adopt-A-Road" sign with your organization, family or business name on it and will be placed at the beginning and end of your adopted area
- Pick up of your bagged trash by our staff...just call when ready
- Satisfaction in knowing that YOU can make a difference....one piece of litter at a time!

Adopt-A-County Road Group Volunteer Waiver
