Peace young Gods and young Earths. My name is Understanding Allah, and I'm originally from the Head of Medina. I was exposed to this Knowledge when I was 8 years old, started learning the correct lessons at the age of 10, and completed 120° on February 2, 1983, approximately 4 months before my 12th birthday. This Knowledge is for the young. All the history of this Nation tells about the firstborn of Mecca and Medina—they were ALL in their pre-teen or teenage years, because ALLAH, the Father, knew and understood that the longevity of this Nation was in teaching the young, and them keeping His teachings and this Nation alive. All praises are due to the Master Architect that designed this, the Master Engineers that built this, and Master Laborers that maintain this.

New Years, Leap Years, Leap Days, and Why We Have Them

If you were born on February 29th—if you're into celebrating birthdays—you're actually supposed to celebrate it once every four years. That sounds crazy, right? It's not—it means you were born on **Leap Day**.

Leap days are important to the Gregorian Calendar—the calendar most commonly used today—because they help match up with the same seasons every year. Man-made calendars typically consist of 365 days. The solar, or tropical, year that influences seasons is approximately 365.2422 days long. A **solar year** measures how long it takes for the Earth to make one revolution around the sun.

Although .2422 of a day may not sound like much, ignoring that bit of a fraction means that eventually our seasons will not fall during the same months every year. For example, the seasons can be so thrown off that your school year might end up starting in the spring instead of the late summer. Another example would be, if the calendar did not match up with the seasons, farmers would have a harder time growing crops, which could affect food supplies. This is the reason why, in the 16th century, the makers of the Gregorian calendar started adding leap days to help match the calendar year to the four seasons.

Now, here's some math for you...

If you multiply 4 x .2422 of a day, it equals .9688, approximately 1 whole day. That extra day every four years—February 29th—is known as leap day, and the year in which it falls is known as **leap year**. Most years that the number is **divisible** by four are leap years. For example, this year, 2024, can be divided by 4 evenly.

Imperfect Calendars

In the past centuries, people from many cultures have attempted to make their own calendars, but they didn't always get them right. Approximately 5,000 years ago, the Sumerians (Original People), who lived in the area that is now called Iraq and Kuwait, divided the year into a 12-months and 30-days each calendar—which made a 360-day year; however, it was a week shorter than Earth's respective journey around the sun. When Egyptians adopted this calendar, they came up with a celebratory solution of just adding five days of partying to the end of the year. Wouldn't we love that nowadays?

Before 3100 BC, earlier Egyptians, as well as people from other cultures in other countries, like ancient China and ancient Rome, used **lunar calendars**, which means that they tracked the months of the year by how long it took for the moon to orbit our planet. But, this caused a shortage of 11-12 days, because the lunar months were about 29.5 days; therefore, the lunar year was only about 354 days. That caused, not only an 11-day gap between the calendar, but also gaps in the seasons.

Today's Islamic calendar, which is used in Saudi Arabia, Syria, and some other Islamic countries, still uses the lunar system, although a single leap day, similar to ours, is sometimes added to keep the seasons the same year after year.

And, even though nowadays China uses the Gregorian calendar for its official purposes—the school year, government business, worldly things—the country also uses a **lunar-solar calendar**, which uses the tracking of *both* the moon's orbit

around Earth and Earth's orbit around the sun, for more of their traditional customs. That's why the Chinese New Year celebrations can float—starting in late January or early February—even though the official calendar year starts on January 1st.

Not confusing enough?

By about the 3rd century B.C., people started getting the hang of their respective calendars. The advanced Egyptians were observing a 365-day year, which included a leap year every four years to correct the calendar. However, as stated before, ancient Rome was still having issues, and Julius Caesar tried to fix theirs in an odd way. He decided that the year 46 B.C. would be 445 days long, instead of 365 days long. That became known as Rome's **Year of Confusion**. Then, he almost got the math right and made a 365.25-day year. This was a tiny bit longer than the 365.2422 solar year, but it added a leap day every four years.

But, even this Roman system wasn't right because the small difference between 365.25 and 365.2422 caused each calendar year to be about 11 minutes shorter than the seasonal calendar, so the calendar would be an entire day shorter every 128 years.

Before they tried something else, in the 16th century, major dates, holidays, and seasons had drifted by 10+ days. Pope Gregory XIII of Rome unveiled his own version of the Gregorian calendar in 1582. That year, he dropped 10 days from the month of October to synchronize things back up. He developed a new leap year system with a solar year of 365.2422 days, added one leap day every four years, but here's the twist, he dropped three leap days every 400 years to keep the calendars from drifting.

This may sound more confusing, but this system has kept the calendar, and the seasons in sync for more than 400 years. The imperfect Gregorian calendar still has a 30-second drift every year. But even with that, the gap is so small that our calendar won't be off for more than a day for another 3,300 years! Do you think that you can create a more precise calendar?

Oh, and by the way, don't worry if your actual birthday falls on February 29th. You're still as old as you think you are—plus you have an excuse to have a *real* special birthday party every four years. And, guess what, you can have a floating birthday on the 28th of February some years, and on the 1st of March other years; however, you can have a very special birthday party every four years on the 29th of February. How cool is that?

BONUS: Why did he/she say that?

The answer; I looked in my communication toolkit and added "sarcasm" and "wit" to the mix (remember; everyone makes their own toolkit). Problem solved! **Generate solutions in real time.** That is one of the greatest skills Knowledge of Self gives. And you can use it every day, in *each and every way*. Peace!

November- Now Cipher Victory

December- Divine Equality See/Destroy Evil See

These were/are not just abbreviations. These are keys of understanding to the times and seasons through which we live. In the words of Dumar Wa'de (PBUH), National Representative, "Let us now be reminded...":

NATIONAL STATEMENT

FEBRUARY 1999

I greet you in my universal language of PEACE! This edition of the National Statement will address the meaning of *Father Equality Born*. For many years brothers and sisters have been involved in celebrating The Father's degree day during the month of February. This form of action manifested by our brothers and sisters is indeed an honorable thing to do, yet, at the same time, I feel a proper understanding must be presented concerning the Father's degree day.

First, you must understand that "Father Equality Born" does not mean February. It only spells February in its abbreviated form. When I use the term "Father Equality Born," I am talking about The *Father's Equality* that was *Born* to the Gods. During the month of February, brothers and sisters should take

special time to examine the history (knowledge and wisdom) of our Nation. In your honorable efforts in celebrating The Father's degree day, you should try to learn the essence of what The Father was teaching. What this means is that you must learn and understand the true meaning of *Father Equality Born*.

Brothers and sisters, my Father made it very clear that He did not want the Gods to worship Him. The Father stated that He wanted the Gods to be greater than Him. He explained that that could only occur when the Gods carried out His teachings. In order for the Gods to carry out The Father's teaching in this day and time, they must know what He taught. You must live according to The Father's teachings as manifested through His vision. To understand The Father's vision, you must bear witness to the works He manifested. In the Year One (1) of our Nation, the Father's Equality was Born to the Gods, alive, through His words and actions.

The Father's words manifested the *knowledge* of who the Original Man is. His words revealed the *wisdom* of the science of what a real devil is. Next, our Father provided *understanding* on the importance of studying ourselves, before we study anyone else. The Father explained that our *freedom* is not in the hands of another man, it must be developed, and come from our *culture*. This is why we teach that the *culture is I-God*, meaning that **God is in yourself, not in the sky.**

The Father showed and proved His *power* by teaching juvenile delinquents, thugs, cut-throats, and all manner of young people in the ghettos of hell. He gave them the *power* to re-define themselves over the very conditions that made them a slave of a mental death and power. The Father blessed us with His *equality* by showing us the science of everything in *life—love, peace and happiness*. This life was not based on the physical plane, it was based on the mental plane. Within the mental plane, we (Gods) learned how to love ourselves, to be at peace with ourselves, and to enjoy the happiness that exists in ourselves.

Next, The Father drew the *Gods* up above 6 by taking us **out of the cipher and off the clock of the man-made time.** It was during this process that our Father revealed how **we are Gods by nature and there was never a God in the sky.** The Father, then, took His time and brought us back to 6 within the cipher of the clock. He explained and manifested the science of how we must master, *build*, or *destroy* in order to bring rain, hail, snow, and earthquakes.

The Father explained that a man will never get above 6 or even travel off the clock as a free man if he cannot make rain, hail, snow, and earthquakes. The Father took us from knowledge to build or destroy and stated that we had to be born ourselves to complete the cipher, the knowledge is born to you and you must be born into the knowledge.

What I have revealed, thus far, is only an introduction of the rites of passage that the Gods went through, walking and talking with The Father.

Brothers and sisters, I feel very proud to see you participating in building our Nation. Most brothers and sisters in our midst today were not even born physically during the time I was speaking about. Yet, in 1999, you are standing tall, and at attention in our struggle. This is why the meaning of Father Equality Born is important for you to understand. Brothers and sisters, it is very important that you have a proper understanding and bear witness to The Father's works, and do not worship something that you do/did not see.

I stated earlier that when brothers and sisters celebrate The Father's degree day, it is an honorable thing to do. However, you cannot honor a man, if you do not honor his works. To honor a man's works, you must understand his vision. The vision is the mathematical manifestation of things we must do and accomplish that The Father set in motion for the Gods and Earths to show and prove. The vision is the Equality that was Born to the Gods by The Father.

At this time, I would like to share with you that Equality that was Born to the Gods by our Father. If you study and examine the following statements, it will help you to understand the vision.

The Father stated...

- "Islam is not a religion, it is our way of life."
- "We are not anti-white nor pro-black."
- "One day, the Gods will have land we can call our own."
- "We must learn skills, trades, and have a proper education."
- "There are no leaders or followers in our Nation."
- "Our job is to teach, and save the babies."
- "We should learn how to fast every month."
- "A day is a thousand years to God."
- "God and the devil work hand-in-hand together. God gets his man and the Devil gets his."
- "We are not Muslims, we are righteous people; therefore, we must create righteous names for ourselves."
- "The names that our parents gave us are *not* slave names or government names, in fact, they are our honorable names, because we are honorable people by nature."
- "The worst death that a person can experience is not a physical death, but a mental death."
- "The greatest education a person can have is Knowledge of Self."
- "When speaking during the Parliament, we must speak about ourselves concerning our Nation, not other people because when you speak on other people in our time frame, all you are doing is teaching for these people."
- "We must learn and understand the science of the clock in order to master time. Everything that occurs and happens is based on the clock. Therefore, we must use our Mathematics to tell time, and the degrees in our lessons to understand how to draw people and events up according to the clock."
- "We must learn to master and understand the meaning of each year, month and day according to Mathematics."
- "You must know the difference between the day's Degree and the day's Mathematics."
- "Every Black seed must have a Brown seed. Every Brown seed must have a Yellow

- seed. Every yellow seed must have a black seed. Meaning the Black, Brown, and Yellow seeds are equal, and they are the Original People."
- "We DO NOT teach the old, unless they have resources to offer the youth."
- "A Black seed is the *knowledge seed*, and always should *do the knowledge*. A Brown seed is the *wisdom seed*, and will *manifest the wisdom*. A Yellow seed is the *understanding seed* and will *bring understanding to the knowledge and wisdom seeds.*"

In 1968, The Father manifested that we are the true and living Gods. He then explained that our women and children, and certain people learning the Knowledge of Self are Five Percenters.

NOTE: There are many brothers who will state that a woman cannot be a Five Percenter. These brothers have been misinformed concerning this matter. Yet, if these brothers want to dispute this fact, more foolishness to them. The Father's word is life. Surely foolishness will only bring you death (mentally).

- "If the Gods ever need Him, all we have to do is come together as one mind, all answers will flow to us concerning anything."
- "If a brother and sister cannot get along based on compatibility, and they agree to separate, that form of action is acceptable."
- "Every God and Earth must properly take care of their children."
- "God does not kill God. If you and another brother have a problem, and it escalates to physical violence, the brother who threw the first punch is wrong."

NOTE: If the science of living Mathematics is our language and Mathematics is Islam, Islam is Mathematics. You can then understand why The Father taught that,

- "There will come a time when the Gods will leave all substances alone. Meaning getting high from man-made chemicals."
- "To master anything, all you have to do is leave it alone."
- "If you owe this government time from a past crime, and you are on the run you must turn yourself in and serve your time. A man cannot teach the truth and do his job right on the run."

NOTE: Many brothers did not listen to The Father then, and there are many brothers who refuse to accept it now. Remember, The Father stated that the devil's job is to get the wrong doers. His job is to teach the good doers. So brothers, it's our call.

• "If you are not right and exact, the devil will not let you get above 6."

Brothers and sisters, the above statements that I have revealed are only some of the things The Father shared with the Gods. He spoke on these statements in more detail. My intentions are only to open your eyes to see the whole cipher of my Father's teachings. In any case, I bear witness that you are trying to do the right thing. Therefore, I feel it is my duty to do the right thing in helping you understand why the Gods honor the Father's degree day.

First of all, it is very important that you understand what the Father taught. I know a large majority of brothers and sisters do not have an inch of knowledge of what The Father was teaching. You can quote lessons right and exact. You have taken on a righteous name and you attend Universal Parliaments. You

have given your time and efforts towards our Nation events. On face value, you would appear to be a good brother or sister in our midst.

Mathematics just does not operate in that manner. The reason I have come to the conclusion is based on how you came into the Knowledge of Self, 95% of brothers and sisters in our Nation feel that the person who presented the knowledge and lessons to them is their Enlightener. In return, these brothers and sisters call themselves students of their so-called Enlightener. The problem is that these so-called Enlighteners never taught you about the true meaning of the equality that The Father *born* to the Gods, These brothers and sisters that call themselves your Enlighteners have good intentions. Yet, they did not have understanding.

Brothers and sisters, the true meaning of Father Equality Born will only come to you by looking into the mirror and asking yourself, who am l? Next, you must understand and realize that the 5% Nation of Gods and Earths is not a religious people. You must accept the fact that there are no leaders or followers in our Nation. This is not to say that there is no leadership or direction in our Nation. The first is the last, and the last is the first.

If you were a brother or sister in school and were not doing your best as a student, then you got the knowledge of yourself, and began to better your grades, and become the best you could be. That is manifesting Father Equality Born in you. That form of progress is the highest level of honoring my Father. If you are a low-down Harry Neckbone-type-of-person, and you applied the knowledge to pull yourself up above hell. Brothers and sisters, that is Father Equality Born.

If you are running around, and your efforts are manifested in an endless circle of failure, you can celebrate February 22nd a thousand years to come, the results will only place you in the Equality that was Born by the founder of unalike attract, alike repel.

The Father's Wisdom taught the Gods to be wise and free. The Father's Equality that was Born to the Gods gave us life. Now, the Gods must Born the Equality of the Father to the children, so that they also may have life. The true and living Gods will not allow you to worship our Father to hide incorrect ways.

Remember, to celebrate the Father's degree day, is to know His vision. Therefore, every God and Earth should give all they have and all within their power to fulfill the vision of our Father.

One must *know the equality* of the father (16), to *born* (show) *the equality* of the Father (26), in order to *see the equality* of the Father (36).


