A GOOD NAME

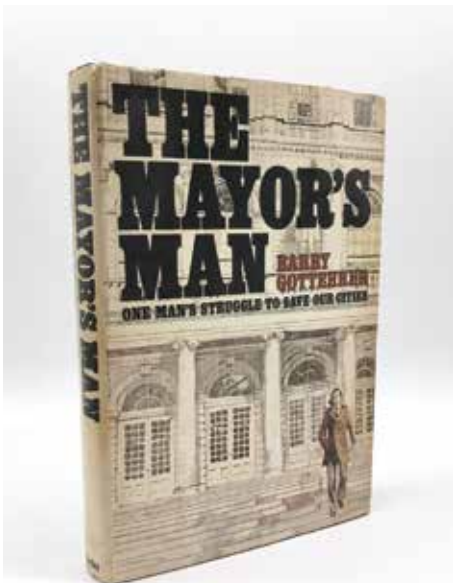

Even though I did not take that opportunity, it taught me that lesson—focus on the goal and task ahead of you. 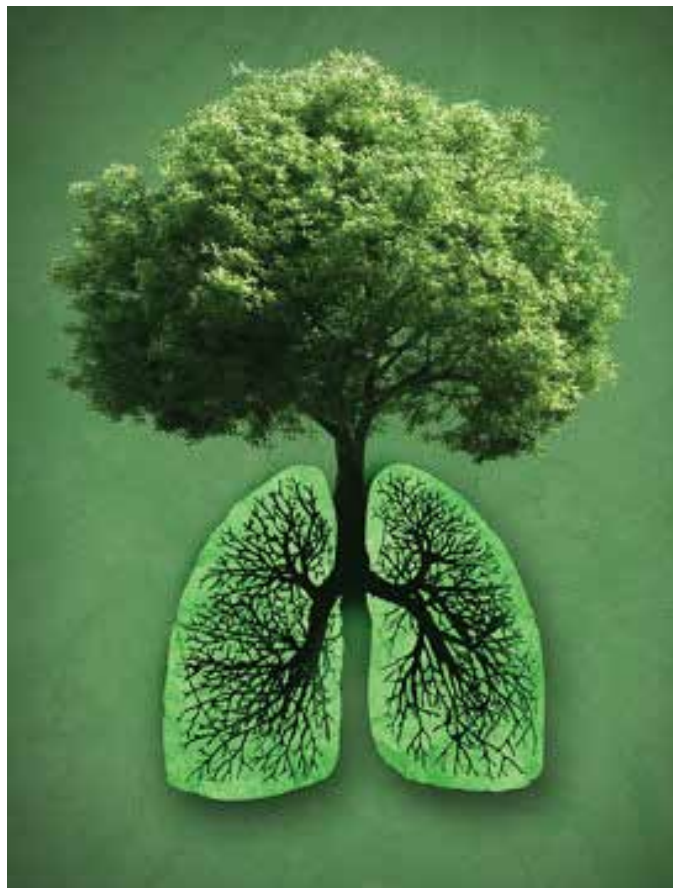
