Prayer Steeple Project: THANKS to everyone who most graciously donated and assisted with the cemetery "Prayer Steeple Project". The renovations on the steeple have been completed. beautiful windows were re-glazed, a leak was repaired in the roof around the cross, painting was done inside, the altar furniture was refinished, new floor covering was installed, and the outside was pressure washed.

The historical steeple has survived since 1911, and it is the hope of the Committee on Records and History that it will continue to survive for

many more years and serve as a landmark in the Church Cemetery and more importantly serve as a place for people to come, pray, and meditate. Burial grounds are important links to the past and their preservation is essential as the landscaping makes any cemetery a peaceful sanctuary. The doors to the "Prayer Steeple" are always open, and you are urged to check out the finished project.



PATH FORWARD TASK FORCE UPDATE:

The vote to pursue disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church passed.

Members of the Admin Council voted at the November 13, 2022, meeting to determine if Cold Springs would remain with the UMC or pursue disaffiliation under Paragraph 2553. The vote to pursue disaffiliation with the UMC passed with the number of votes outlined below:

- <u>0</u> Votes for the option to stay with the UMC and accept the progressive views of proposed changes in the Discipline
- <u>20</u> Votes to pursue disaffiliation and join another denomination with traditional Methodist views

Paragraph 2553 allows the church to disaffiliate for reasons of conscience over issues involving church doctrine or practices regarding homosexuality.

Based on the outcome of this vote, Cold Springs UMC will pursue disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church. The next step requires that the results of the vote be communicated to the District Superintendent. Additional information regarding a date for the congregational vote will be provided once we hear from the District Superintendent.
