

Barn Wellness Days:

Bringing our complete wellness care to your boarding barn!

Clients are encouraged to come for their appointment – start time is every 1 hour for small groups, 30 minutes for medium and large groups. Each horse will be examined for approximately 1 hour.

What to Expect? An hour of focused equine veterinary care for your horse. No shortcuts, no skipping steps, everything you need to make sure your horse is perfectly prepared for the upcoming season.

- ➔ Head to tail physical: Thoracic and abdominal auscultation. Back, Neck and Pelvis Range of Motion and palpation. Eye exam. Tendon and ligament palpation. Joint palpation and range of motion. Hoof testing. Basic soundness exam: walk/trot straight linen, walk trot canter lunge circle (must have adequate facilities. Basic flexion tests (full limb, all four legs).
- ➔ Coggins Test (Global Vet Link)
- ➔ Equine Vaccinations: Flu, Rhino, WNV, Tetanus, WEE, EEE, Rabies (Lyme, Strangles, Intra-Nasal Flu also available).
- ➔ Quantitative Fecal Egg Count: Analyzed in House by our Imagyst Digital Fecal Egg Assessment System plus manual tape testing for Pinworms
- ➔ Comprehensive Oral Exam with Dental Charting and Complete Dental Float. Our Wellness Days also include Level 1 extractions if indicated (caps, wolf teeth, expired molars) and Level 1 periodontal disease treatment if identified (pockets or diastemata flushed and packed).
- ➔ Sheath Clean or Udder Wash

The owner of each horse is provided with results of the complete physical exam, recommended conditioning protocols, automated Fecal Egg Count results with recommended deworming protocols, a copy of their vaccination certificate, and a copy of their complete dental chart with dental care summarized.

Many of our wellness patients have recommended follow up: this may include dental x-rays, farrier balance x-rays, gastroscopies, hock injections, chiropractic, or acupuncture.

Recommended follow-up care can be booked for 30- days after your wellness appointment and professional services are discounted 20% for all recommended follow-up care.

Total/Horse - \$517.50 (Coggins not included- can be added for \$75).

6 -8 Horses: One Vet and one assistant - book $\frac{3}{4}$ - all day

9-16 horses: Two vets, 2-3 assistants $\frac{3}{4}$ to all day

17-24 Horses: Three Vets, 3-4 assistants - $\frac{3}{4}$ to all day
