Before The Reunion:

How are we doing Harvest City? This week is an exciting week. Our friend Nick Powell is preparing to plant an Acts 29 church in Clinton, IA. He is going to preach to us on the topic of church planting and hopefully let us know how we can partner with him in this KINGDOM advancing endeavor! Here are some recommendations we have for you as you prepare for worshiping God as a family this Sunday morning:

- Please remember to bring masks for each person in your family as we are requiring them to be worn during the Reunion. (One-time use masks will be available for those who don't have one.)
- Gather chairs or a blanket for your family to sit on during church. (Put them in your car)
- Gather communion elements (Substitutes are ok if you're low on wine, juice or bread.)
- Print out your kid's activity pages (This week we have preschool, younger and older kids!)
- As we worship outside you may want to consider bringing an umbrella, sunscreen, bug spray and water bottles as well as anything you need to keep your children occupied.
- We won't have a place to give outside... No pressure here AT ALL, but this may be a good time to give online if you don't have recurring gifts set up in Planning Center and you want to worship God in this way. - Please consider parking EVERY OTHER spot in the top half of the parking lot. From there you will see a greeter to direct you to the back lawn. Once you're on the back lawn you should be able to find a painted square for you, you and your spouse or you and your family. Keep in mind there are two different size of squares... the bigger ones should be saved for families and the smaller ones for individuals or couples.

Bathrooms:

Try to remember to use the restroom before you come. There will be restrooms available indoors, but they will be limited to one person at a time.

Liturgy:

Our hope is that this Reunion be similar to a "normal" Sunday Reunion from before the quarantine... except OUTSIDE!

During the Reunion you will need to pull up Slack or go to the website in order to see the lyrics for the songs. If you'd like to... you can print them off ahead of time.

After The Reunion:

When we checked in with Johnson County Public Health they recommended having people leave one square at a time. We will try to direct people to leave in an orderly manner to limit the amount of mingling with the hope of being as safe as possible.
